MAYCO ACRYLIC STAINS USED ON THIS FLYER: SS-135 White, SS-45 Buttermilk, SS-317 Turquoise, SS-254 Golden Ochre, SS-210 Orange, SS-198 Chocolate, SS-234 Medium Mocha, SS-276 Forest Green, SS-376 Limeburst, SS-24 Chocolate Fudge, SS-335 Rich Blue, SS-111 Brightest Yellow, SS-, SS-331 Med. Blue, SS-176 Christmas Red, SS-57 Accent Green, SS-19 Country Sage, SS-3 Honey Toast, and SS-138 Flat Black.

COLOR MIXES: Dark Blue- a mix of Rich Blue and very little Black, light blue mix- 3:1:1 White, Turquoise and Med. Blue. **PINK MIX** -Light Pink a little Med. Mocha and Christmas Red.

SPECIALITIES: Mayco non-fire Snow, Mayco AC-501 Gloss Sealer.

MAYCO BRUSHES USED: AB-834 ¾" Basecoat, RB-138 3/8" Angled Shader, Various size RB and size 4, 6 & 8 round CB brushes, 10/0 Mini Liner, CB 110, Script Liner CB 106, UB and round AB Drybrushes.

PREPARATION: Place all holes in trees and bases for lights and electrical. Place hole in hands if desired. Place holes as desired in the fairy wings. . Place holes for pin and globe lights as desired. We glue the wings on after all items are painted and decorated. Clean and fire to cone 04.

BASECOAT: Lady pines with Medium Blue and Wispy Pines and bases with Buttermilk. If using angel or fairy wings, basecoat with Buttermilk. Once the blue areas are finished, the face hair and sash are basecoated.

PAINT: A slightly thinned coat of metallic gold to all basecoated areas. Allow to Dry.

DRYBRUSH: LADY PINES: Two coats of Medium Blue to lady pines, continue drybrushing adding White to your brush with each coat especially highlighting tips of branches and higher areas. Continue to highlight with a fresh drybrush and White; 2 coats. **WHISPY PINE TREES wings and bases:** Drybrush 2 to 3 coats of Buttermilk followed with 2 to 3 coats of White added to your brush.

BASECOAT: Lady's hair with a **pale yellow mix** of Honey Toast and Buttermilk. Basecoat lady pines sashes with Buttermilk. **PAINT:** A slightly thinned coat of metallic gold to these basecoated areas. Allow to Dry.

DRYBRUSH: Sashes with Buttermilk followed with White. Drybrush hair with original basecoat color, followed lightly with Buttermilk then White added to your brush.

BASECOAT: Flesh areas with Light Taupe. **PAINT:** A slightly thinned coat of metallic gold to the flesh areas. Allow to Dry.

DRYBRUSH: Flesh areas with 3 light coats of Light Taupe, blush face and hands lightly with blush color of choice. If the flesh is too bluish go back with more Light Taupe to soften. Continue to blush cheeks only, until desired effect is achieved.

PAINT: Eyes. Apply eyeshadow to eye lids with Medium Blue.

SHADE: Lady Pines, fairy and angel wings as shown or desired with the **Dark Blue Mix**.

FINISH: Glue clear pin lights to all pines. Apply No Fire Snow to bases, scrape off any excess snow from the top of base so base remains flat, before the snow dries sprinkle extra fine Glitz Glitter from Recollection Brand. Apply this extra fine glitter to Angel and Fairy wings using Mayco's paint on gloss sealer, apply glitter before sealer dries.

Use Creatology Iridescent glitter to the ends of all branches of all trees, and high areas of bodice's and sleeves. Apply all glitter using Gloss Sealer.

PREPARATION: After removing casts from molds, cut out stars and holes and place all holes for electrical. Place holes for pin lights as desired. Allow to dry, clean and fire to cone 04. Use high fire ornament wire for ornaments.

BASECOAT: **Buttermilk**-All white areas, **Light blue mix**- snow areas and roofs. **Turquoise** all Blue areas, **Limeburst** all green areas, **Pink mix** all pink areas and **Orange** all beaks.

PAINT: A slightly thinned coat of metallic gold to all basecoated areas. Allow to Dry.

DRYBRUSH: Drybrush Buttermilk areas with 2 to 3 coats of Buttermilk followed with 1 to 2 coats of White. Drybrush blue areas with the **light blue mix** followed with two coats of White. Continue with White using a fresh brush to further whiten. Blush cheeks as desired. **Dry brush green areas** with Limeburst, followed with Brightest Yellow and White. **Pink areas** with, **PINK MIX** followed with White. **Turquoise areas** with Turquoise, followed with White. **Orange areas** with Orange, brightest Yellow and White.

PAINT: Using Flat Black paint black areas of penguins. Use Med. Blue to paint the words. Paint the house Christmas Red.

FINISH: Using gloss sealer and Extra fine Glitz Glitter, apply to scarves and hats. Use Creatology Iridescent glitter to fur trim. Apply snow to trees and snow areas and before the snow dries apply the extra fine glitter. Glue in pin lights.

SHADE: All snow areas with a **dark blue mix** (Rich Blue and add Black slowly for a dark Blue).

PREPARATION: After removing casts from molds, place all holes for lights and electrical. Place holes in hands if desired. Using various sized hole tools make holes in the fairy wings. Place holes for pin lights as desired. Allow to dry and fire to cone 04.

PREPARATION for Bulb Ornaments in trees: If cutting out holes for Christmas bulb ornaments in the pines, do this first. Have the ornaments that you will be using on hand for a guide on the size hole to create. We used various size hole and socket hole cutters. You can expand the size hole as needed. Do not put the holes too close together as the greenware will become weak. Check hole with Christmas bulb ornaments or even various size pretty round beads (to use as "bulbs" for your Pines) for size, remember to allow for shrinkage. Plastic Christmas bulb ornaments are the best as they have some give. Once fired and finished and the hole is too large for the ornament, use No Fire Snow or even spackling compound to line the hole before placing the ornament. This will set the bulb as well as fill gaps. Attach the bulbs and beads once item is fully painted.

BASECOAT: White areas with Buttermilk, green areas with Accent Green, Yellow hair with Honey Toast, brown hair with Chocolate and red hair with Light Umber. Flesh areas with Light Taupe.

PAINT: A thin coat of Metallic Gold to all areas except the Accent Green. Let Dry

DRYBRUSH: All White areas with 2 coats Buttermilk, followed with 3 coats of White. Green areas with 2 coats of Forest Green, followed with 2 coats of Country Sage. Continue with 2 to 3 coats of Limeburst, followed with 3 coats of Brightest Yellow. Highlight with White. Yellow hair with Honey Toast and White. Light Umber hair with Light Umber, Orange, Brightest Yellow and Buttermilk. Brown hair with Chocolate, Med. Mocha, Golden Ochre followed with White to highlight. Flesh areas with 3 light coats of Light Taupe, blush face and hands lightly with blush color of choice. If the flesh is to blushy go back with more Light Taupe to soften. Continue to blush cheeks only, until desired effect is achieved.

SHADE: Shade face, under and around eyes, blond hair and angel wings with Med. Mocha. Shade red and brown hair with Chocolate Fudge. Line mouth and eye brow with Med. Mocha. Paint eye lids with slightly watered down White. Paint angel and fairies sash with metallic gold.

FINISH: Apply snow to areas where desired and sprinkle Recollections extra fine Glitz glitter before the snow dries. Glitz glitter is also on all wings. Use Creatology Iridescent glitter to the ends of all branches of green trees, and high areas of bodice's and sleeves. Use Recollections Clear Gold Embossing powder on the gold sashes. Apply all glitter using Gloss Sealer.
