## ROCK SLAB MOLD NUMBER 3027 Lg. Rock Slab 16"T x 14"W \$108.00

**PREPARATION:** After removing cast from mold, clean seam. Using a rough rock or similar object, press onto seam line to mimic rough rock texture. Cut out flag (pattern available from our website) or Halloween design as desired. "God Bless America" is using the Castellar font size 175 bold and Italic. To cut out letters leave a break in the letters as shown. RIP is using the same font at size 200, bold but not italic. Cut out stars using Kemper star punch tool. Bat design is available from our website. After cutting out design and letters, carefully clean using a sponge and a brush. Place hole for electrical. Allow to dry and fire to cone 04.

**BASECOAT:** Carefully fill inside of rock slabs with plastic grocery bags to prevent the inside of the slab to be painted with the basecoat color. Apply Light Taupe to the flag slab and Flat Black to the Halloween slab. **ANTIQUE:** Flag slab only with Golden Buckskin Twinkle, be sure to antique the inside edge of letters and flag design; carefully wipe off excess with a soft cloth.

**DRYBRUSH:** Flag slab with one to two coats of the following: Light Taupe, Light Tan and Buttermilk. Adding White in your brush highlight lightly here and there. Drybrush Halloween slab with Regal Purple and Deep Purple. Drybrush these colors on a 45 degree angle. Highlight clouds and top of bats with extra coats.

**PAINT:** Blue area of flag with Navy, red areas with Cranberri, flag pole with Chocolate.

DRYBRUSH: blue area of Flag with Dark Blue followed lightly with Rich Blue.

**PAINT:** Veins in rock using the Mayco script liner apply a watered down white line on an angle as shown. Using a 10/0 liner apply heavier lines of White and Slate Gray and Flat Black as shown.

## EAGLE

#### MOLD NUMBER

#### 3028 Lg. Eagle 14"T x 15"W \$128.00

#### BASECOAT: 04 bisque Eagle as follows: Buttermilk to white areas, Chocolate Fudge to Eagle's brown areas and logs, Slate Gray to bark areas and Brick Red to Eagle beak and legs.

**ANTIQUE:** With Golden Buckskin Twinkle, wipe off excess with a soft cloth. **DRYBRUSH:** Drybrush Eagle's brown areas and logs with 2 coats of Chocolate Fudge followed with Chocolate, very lightly highlight feathers with a small amount of Medium Mocha in your brush. Continue drybrushing logs with Medium Mocha followed with Light Umber to the center of the logs. Finish drybrushing the center of the logs with Golden Ocher followed with a touch of Buttermilk. Drybrush gray bark with Slate Gray and then White. Drybrush Beak and legs with Brick Red followed with Orange and Golden Ocher. Continue beak with Honey Toast. Highlight beak lightly with Buttermilk added to your brush. Drybrush white areas with 2 to 3 coats of Buttermilk highlight lightly with White. Drybrush tips of white wing feathers with Flat Black as shown.

PAINT: Claws with Flat Black.

**SHADE:** Eagle and logs as shown using Flat Black.

**PAINT:** Eagle's eyes using Buttermilk for the iris. (Follow Sharon Kinzie's Eagle eye painting instructions)

# **BUNDLE UP TURKEYS**

MOLD NUMBERS

#### 3030 Tom Turkey 5.5"T x 5"W \$35.00 3031 Thomas Turkey 5"T x 5"W \$35 3032 Mr. T Turkey 6"T x 5"W \$35.00 3033 Turkey/Chicken Feet & Knees 1" - 2" \$28.00

**PREPARATION:** After removing casts from mold, slip attach head to turkey body. If using feet and knees on turkeys, place holes in lower body as shown. Place a <sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub> inch hole in turkey feet and knees.

Allow to dry, clean and using a damp sponge, lightly dab to retexture surface; fire to cone 04.

**BASECOAT:** Turkey beak and feet with Brick Red, waddle with Cranberrie, basecoat all other areas with Medium Mocha.

**ANTIQUE:** Golden Buckskin Twinkle, wipe off excess with a soft cloth.

**DRYBRUSH:** Medium Mocha to Medium Mocha areas, continue with Light Umber, highlight with Buttermilk added to your brush. Drybrush Feathers at

the base with Brick Red, moving up the feather continue with Orange, Golden Ochre and Honey Toast, highlight with Buttermilk added to your brush. Drybrush beak and feet with Brick Red followed with Orange Rust and Orange. Highlight with Buttermilk added to your brush. Drybrush waddle with Cranberrie.

**PAINT:** Clear sealer to beak, waddle and feet. Paint eyes using Rich Blue for the irises. Shade feathers and face area as shown with Chocolate Fudge and then Flat Black if desired.

**FINISH:** If desired attach feet and knees to turkeys using torn cotton material. Tear 1 ½ inch strip of cotton material (both sides of the strip should be torn). Thread cotton into turkey's body and knot the cotton strip. Pull the strip taut outside the turkey and thread the knee on the cotton strip and then the turkey foot. Tie knot to desired length of the leg. For turkeys bow tie use ½ inch strip of torn cotton.

**PREPARATION**: Cut out pumpkins as desired **(Classic Turkey stencil by zombiepumpkins.com'')** Cut out Oak leaves on Happy Thanksgiving pumpkin, if desired slip attach cut out Oak leaf onto pumpkin as shown. After cutting out design and letters, carefully clean using a sponge and a brush. Place holes for electrical. Cut out Happy, Jolly and Joyful pumpkin as shown, if attaching cloth legs place cut out stars as shown. Allow to dry and fire to cone 04.

**BASECOAT:** Avoiding the interior of the pumpkins, (fill inside with plastic grocery bags) basecoat with Chocolate Fudge.

**DRYBRUSH:** All pieces with 2 coats of Chocolate continue pumpkin stems with 1 to 2 coats of Medium Mocha followed Light Umber and Golden Ochre. Highlight with Buttermilk added to your brush. With a fresh brush drybrush 2 to 3 coats of Brick Red to Pumpkins followed with 2 to 3 coats of Orange. Highlight pumpkins with Honey Toast added to your brush; 1 to 2 coats; further highlight by adding Brightest Yellow to your brush. Blush the cheeks of Happy, Jolly and Joyful pumpkin with a small amount of Coral Rose added to your brush.

**DRYBRUSH:** Drybrush pumpkin leaves on Happy, Jolly and Joyful with 2 to 3 coats of Artichoke followed with Golden Ocher added to your brush.

FINISH: Attach cloth legs to pumpkins as instructed in the finish area of the Turkey instructions. Use wood hearts for the feet and wood beads as shown.
