MATERIALS NEEDED

OPAQUE STAINS: Deep Brown, Electric Blue, Christmas Red, Marigold yellow, Bright Orange, Victorian Green, Vanilla, White, Sky Blue, Dark Blonde, Peach Blush and Black.

SPECIALTIES: Crystal Ice Glimmerz, Opal Glitter It.

PREPARATION: Place high-fire ornament hooks in damp ornament casts. Retexture textured seam lines with TL-9 texture tool.

BASECOAT: All pieces with Deep Brown.

DRYBRUSH: All white areas of penguins, sign poles and fur trim with 3 to 4 coats of Vanilla followed with 1 to 2 coats of White. Blush cheeks with Peach Blush. Using a fresh brush, drybrush penguins' beaks and feet with 2 to 3 coats of Bright Orange followed with 2 coats of Dark Blonde added to your brush to highlight.

REBASECOAT: All other areas with the following colors to the appropriate area using the flyer as your guide: Christmas Red, Victorian Green, Electric Blue, Marigold Yellow and Black.

DRYBRUSH: All red areas with Christmas Red and Bright Orange mixed, lightly highlight with a very small amount of Dark Blonde in your brush. All other colors drybrush the basecoat color with Vanilla added to your brush to highlight. Lightly highlight with a small amount of White added to your brush. Drybrush black areas with Black and a small amount of Vanilla in your brush.

PAINT: Paint snow on signs and snowflakes with Sky Blue.

DRYBRUSH: White onto snow on signs and snowflakes, using a small brush, stomp the White onto the snow on the signs to speed up the process.

PAINT: Red stripes on poles with Christmas Red. If desired, paint sign messages with White. Nails on signs with Black. Hot dog bun is Navajo and hot dog is Navajo with Christmas Red added. Paint all eyes and eyelashes using Electric Blue for the irises. Also paint Crystal Ice Glimmerz to all fur trim and snow and snowflakes.

TREE BASE AND SNOWFLAKES Mold Numbers

MATERIALS NEEDED

OPAQUE STAINS: Night Blue, Sky Blue, White, and Blue Green Mix – 2:2:1 Sherwood Green, Electric Blue and Vanilla.

SPECIALTIES: Crystal Ice Glimmerz and Opal Glitter It.

PREPARATION: After removing casts from mold, slip attach base to trees, mend attached area to disguise. Place holes in trees using the lg. End of the #1 Clay Lift tool for Christmas lights and place hole in base for electrical. If using the small snowflakes for miniature ornaments, place high-fire ornament wire into snowflake after removing snowflakes from mold. Retexture textured seam lines with the TL-9 texture tool. Fire to proper cone.

BASECOAT: Second and fifth tree with Night Blue and all other trees with Blue Green Mix.

DRYBRUSH: Night Blue trees with the Blue Green Mix and drybrush all trees with the Mix adding Vanilla to the Mix with each added drybrush coat. Highlight with White added to your brush about two coats.

BASECOAT: Neatly rebasecoat snow on trees and base with Sky Blue. Basecoat all snowflakes with Sky Blue.

DRYBRUSH: White onto Sky Blue areas. To speed up process, stomp White onto snow on trees and base.

PAINT: Crystal Ice Glimmerz to snowflakes and snow on trees and base. Paint Opal Glitter It over entire trees and base.
