PREPARATION: After removing casts from molds make snowflakes, cut out stars and holes as desired. Place all holes in bases as needed for electrical. Allow to dry, clean and fire to cone 04.

BASECOAT: Color to areas as follows: **Emperors Gold** – snowmen's hat and mitten trim, **Buttermilk** – to all other white areas, including the white area of the Snow Cliff, **Gray Blue** – to the ice cubes, signs and the base of the Penguin Tree. The light blue areas of the white Snow Cliff and the light blue hanging Snowflakes. **Orange** to snowmen noses and penguin's beaks and feet, **Antique**

Red – Red areas, **Chocolate Fudge** – brown areas, **Navy Blue** to “Snowfall’s” hat, dark blue Snow Cliff and hanging Snowflakes, **Dark Blue** to all Medium Blue areas, **Accent Green** – Green areas. Penguin’s black areas will be basecoated in the following instructions.

ANTIQUÉ: With a 1:1 mix of Ginny Tan Twinkle and Golden Buckskin Twinkle, wipe off excess with a soft cloth.

DRYBRUSH: Emperors Gold – to snowmen’s hat and mitten trim, continue with 2 to 3 coats of Buttermilk, highlight with White. **Buttermilk** - to white areas with 3 coats, follow with 2 coats of White. Blush cheeks lightly with Coral Rose added to your brush. Drybrush orange beaks and feet with 2 to 3 coats of Orange, highlight with Buttermilk added to your brush. Drybrush **Red areas** with 2 coats of Antique Red, 2 coats of Red and 2 coats with Orange added to your brush. **Dark Blue areas** with 1 coat of Dark Blue followed with 2 coats Dark Gray Blue and 1 coat of Gray Blue, highlight with White added to your brush. **Brown areas** with Chocolate Fudge followed with Chocolate, Medium Brown and Light Umber, very lightly highlight with Buttermilk added to your brush. **Green Areas** with Accent Green followed with Forest Green and Country Sage. Drybrush snowflakes on the JOY and SNOW lightly, with White.

BASECOAT: Black areas of penguins with Flat Black.

DRYBRUSH: These black areas with Navy Blue followed lightly with Dark Blue, highlight with a small amount of White added to your brush.

PAINT: Eyes on penguins on penguin tree using Rich Blue for the irises. All other eyes Flat Black. Add a small dot of White to highlight. Using **Emperors Gold**, paint detail of Snowmen, Penguin Tree and Base as desired. Words on Penguin Tree signs were antiqued with Emperors Gold. When antiquing with Emperors Gold, do one sign at a time and wipe off excess very quickly.

SHADE: Snowmen with Dark Blue.

FINISH: Glue in pin lights and hook up with electrical. **Apply No Fire Snow as desired.** Make scarves using No-Sew Fleece.

STROKE AND COAT USED: SC-16 Cotton Tail, SC-2 Melon Choly, SC-75 Orange a Peel, SC-15 Tuxedo, SC-74 Hot Tamale, SC-26 Green Thumb, SC-14 Java Bean, SC-5 Tiger Tail, SC-32 Bluebeard, SC-45 My Blue Heaven SC-46 Rawhide, SC-31 The Blues, and SC-41 Brown Cow.

GLAZE: SG-303 Confetti

PENGUIN STACK AND CONE: Apply 3 coats of 1:1:1 mix of Tiger Tail, Rawhide and Brown Cow to sugar cone. Apply 1 to 2 coats of Cotton Tail to all faces of the penguins. Sponge on 3 coats of Melon Choly to cheeks, allow drying between coats. Apply 2 coats of Orange a Peel to penguin's beaks. If desired shade faces of penguins with The Blues. Paint red hat with 3 coats of Hot Tamale. Paint eyes and black areas of penguins with 2 coats of Tuxedo.

SNOWMAN, PENGUIN PLATES AND SLEEPY PENGUINS: Apply 2 coats of Cotton Tail to all white areas. Sponge on 3 coats of Melon Choly to cheeks, allow drying between coats. Apply 3 coats of the following colors to areas. Orange a Peel – orange areas. Green Thumb – green areas. Hot Tamale – red areas. The Blues – Blue Snowman scarf. My Blue Heaven – Penguin's pillow. Bluebeard – Penguins dark blue areas. Line penguins and Snowman with Cotton Tail and Tuxedo as shown.

REINDEER AND MOOSE: Apply one even coat of 2:1 Tiger Tail and water to reindeer and one even coat of 1:1 Java Bean and water to moose. When dry apply one very watered down coat of Java Bean to reindeer and one very watered down coat of Tiger Tail to moose. Paint hooves and reindeer noses with 2 coats of Tuxedo and horns with 3 coats of Java Bean. If desired paint one reindeer nose with Hot Tamale. Line with Tuxedo.

DIP AND FIRE: Dip pieces in Clear Blu dipping, when dry or if desired apply one coat of Confetti to plates before firing.
Fire to cone 06.

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
