Materials Needed

GLAZE: Sand River Rock or desired glaze for inside of pumpkin cat and bat and spider pots.

OPAQUE STAINS: Lemon Grass, Avocado, Medium Green, Persimmon, Crimson, Orange Peel, Peach, Curry, Dark Yellow, Ivory, Purple, Lilac, Concord, Pansy, Navy Blue, Northern Blue, Bright Blue, Chocolate Fudge, Saddle Brown, Medium Brown, Charcoal, Ash, Black and White.

TRANSLUCENT STAINS: Pecan Sparkle and Tan Sparkle.

PREPARATION: Cut out all areas desired for lighting, place proper holes for electrical hook up. To make cat pumpkin into a candleholder, place a quarter size hole in the top of the cat pumpkin and cut out a large area in the back of the pumpkin to insert the candle. Place the wet greenware on a flat mold or plaster bat and squeeze slip into the pourgate areas using a squeeze bottle, such as a ketchup or mustard dispenser. Allow casts to dry. Clean greenware replacing detail and texture. Fire to cone 04.

GLAZE: Inside of pumpkin cat if using for a candle and inside of bat and spider pots, clean up any drips, fire to cone 06.

BASECOAT: Color to pieces to follows: **Lemon Grass** to White Ghosts, **Avocado** to green ghosts, witches flesh areas, kitty's Happy Halloween sign, all pumpkin leaves and light cord, and Ghost for Hire's base. **Purple** to purple ghosts, **Persimmon** to all orange area, and Curry to all yellow areas. Saddle Brown – to all brown areas.

ANTIQUE: Using a 1:1 mix of Tan Sparkle and Pecan Sparkle, antique all painted areas, wipe off excess with a soft cloth.

DRYBRUSH: Color to areas as follows **Lemon Grass** – 2 coats of Lemon Grass followed with 4 coats of White, for a brighter ghost, add more coats of White to the higher areas. Blush cheeks lightly with Peach added to your brush. **Purple** – 2 coats of Purple, followed with 2 coats of Lilac, followed with 2 to 3 coats of White. Blush cheeks lightly with Peach added to your brush. **Persimmon** – 2 coats of Persimmon, continue with 2 to 3 coats of Orange Peel. Highlight all orange areas excluding pots with Oriental Flesh added to your brush. **Curry** – 2 to 3 coats of Curry, followed with 2 coats of Dark Yellow, continue with Oriental Flesh added to your brush. Blush moon's cheeks and nose lightly with Peach added to your brush. **Avocado** – **To** "boo" ghosts and kitty's sign: 1 to 2

coats, followed with 2 to 3 coats of Lemon Grass, highlight adding White to your brush. **To witch's flesh:** 2 coats of Avocado highlight with Lemon Grass. **To pumpkin leaves, light cord and base:** 1 to 2 coats of Avocado, followed with 1 to 2 coats of Avocado and Medium Green mixed, highlight adding Ivory to your brush. **Saddle Brown** – 1 to 2 coats to brown areas, followed with 1 to 2 coats of Medium Brown, highlight lightly with Goldenrod added to your brush.

PAINT: Spider, bats, kitty, purple and black areas of melting witch and "BOO" of the boo ghosts carefully and neatly using Black.

DRYBRUSH: 2 to 3 coats of Concord to all purple areas, highlight lightly using Pansy. Blush spider's cheeks using Crimson.

PAINT: Witch's shoes, hatband and buckle, and pads of kitty's feet using Black. **DRYBRUSH:** Charcoal, then Ash lightly to pads of kitty's feet and sole of witch's shoe.

PAINT: Eyes and words on signs, use Bright Blue for the irises. Paint Antique Gold to hat buckle. Paint gloss sealer to witch's hatband and shoes.

Materials Needed

OPAQUE STAINS: Bright Blue, Chocolate Fudge, Walnut, Saddle Brown, Rust, Burnt Orange, Persimmon, Orange Peel, Oriental Flesh, Ivory, White,

Avocado, Medium Green, Sherwood Dark, Rain Forest Green, Fire Thorn, Medium Brown, Black, Charcoal and Ash.

ULTRA METALLICS: Antique Gold

MISC.: Small flame pin lights and Lg. Globe lights.

PREPARATION: While greenware is still damp place holes for lights and electrical. Clean greenware and replace detail and texture. Fire to cone 04.

BASECOAT: All items using Chocolate Fudge.

DRYBRUSH: Turkey body areas, feathers, collar, log, signs and sign posts as follows: Saddle Brown, 2 to 3 coats to all areas. Excluding log, sign and sign posts, drybrush these same areas with 2 coats of Rust. Using Burnt Orange, drybrush the previous areas except the top edge of the tail feathers with 2 coats. Using Persimmon, Orange Peel and Oriental Flesh drybrush these same areas but with each color drybrush less and less of the tail feather. Highlight lightly with Ivory. Continue to drybrush collar with 2 to 3 coats of White. Drybrush hat band with 3 coats of Rust. Continue sign, signposts and logs with Medium Brown, highlight signs with Butterscotch and Oriental Flesh. Drybrush Pumpkins with 2 coats of Persimmon, followed with 2 coats of Orange Peel, highlight lightly with Oriental Flesh. Drybrush base, pumpkin leaves, stems and light cord with 2 to 3 coats of Avocado followed with 1 to 2 coats of Avocado and Medium Green mixed, lightly highlight adding Oriental Flesh to your brush.

BASECOAT: Vest and "Turkey" with Sherwood Dark. Drybrush Sherwood Dark

areas with Rain Forest Green. Basecoat beak and waddle with Chocolate Fudge. Drybrush beak with Saddle Brown, continue beak with Butterscotch, highlight with Oriental Flesh. Drybrush waddle with Fire Thorn. Basecoat hat, shoes and bow with Black. Drybrush black areas lightly with Charcoal, then Ash.

PAINT: Buckles and stripes on vest with Bright Gold. Paint eyes using Bright Blue for the irises.

FINISH: Glue in globe and flame pin lights, hook up with electrical. Color by Duncan
