Materials Needed

OPAQUE STAINS: Deep Brown, Walnut, Medium Brown, Country Gold, Vanilla, Night Blue, Electric Blue, Sherwood Green, Victorian Green, Marigold, Royal Purple, Burgundy, Crimson, Christmas Red, Black Forest Green, Victorian Green, Sky Blue, Bright Orange, Pumpkin, Confederate Grey, Hot Pink, Soft Pink, Dark Flesh, Black and White. **PINK MIX - 3:1** Soft Pink and Antique Rose.

SPECIALTIES: Crystal Ice, Silver Slipper and Gold Dust Glimmers. Regency Gold, Magic Potion, and Ruby Glitter It. Peach Blossom, Yellow Chiffon and Baby Kisses Shimmers. Water Base Gold and Water Base Silver.

PREPARATION: While greenware is damp place high fire ornament wire in top of ornament. Replace textured seamlines with the TL-9 texture tool when greenware is dry. When properly cleaned fire to cone 05.

BASECOAT: All pieces with Deep Brown.

DRYBRUSH: All bear fur and reindeer fur and antlers areas as follows: Drybrush 3 to 4 coats of Walnut Brown followed with 2 to 3 coats of Medium Brown. Continue with 1 to 2 coats of Country Gold followed with Vanilla to highlight. Blush bear cheeks lightly with Peach Blush. Drybrush the following areas the same as the bear fur areas: beard and hat trim of the Santa bear head ornaments, the hats on the bear with trains, bellies of the penguins, music sheet

of the carolers, feathers, top of drum and drum sticks on soldiers and chocolate chip cookies on the two cookie bears. Give the cookies an extra highlight coat of Vanilla and all other areas mentioned 2 to 3 coats of Vanilla. Highlight beard and hat trim with 2 coats of White.

REBASECOAT: Paint Water Base Gold to bear angels wings, angel girls gown and angel boy's sash. Paint Water Base Gold to all areas of the baby's first Christmas ornament avoiding the bear's fur. Rebasecoat ballerina bears costume and shoes with the Pink Mix. Rebasecoat all other areas that have been over drybrushed with Deep Brown.

DRYBRUSH: Colors as follows: RED: 2 coats of Burgundy followed with 2 to 3 coats of Christmas Red. DARK PINK: (lover bear) 2 coats of Burgundy followed with 2 to 3 coats of Crimson, lightly highlight with Vanilla. WHITE: 2 to 3 coats of Vanilla highlight with White. BALLERINA PINK: 3 to 4 coats of Pink Mix and Vanilla mixed. With each coat add more Vanilla to your brush. Highlight lightly with Vanilla. BRIGHT PINK: (baby's first Christmas) 1 to 2 coats of Hot Pink followed with 2 to 3 coats of Vanilla added to your brush to highlight. PURPLE: 2 coats of Royal Purple followed with Vanilla to highlight. GREEN: 2 coats of Black Forest Green followed with 3 coats of Victorian Green, highlight with Vanilla. Add Marigold Yellow to your brush for the green on the clown. YELLOW: 3 to 4 coats of Marigold, highlight with Vanilla. BLUE: 2 coats of Night Blue followed with 2 coats of Electric Blue. Highlight with Vanilla. GINGERBREAD: 2 coats of Autumn Rust followed with 2 coats of Navajo. Highlight with Vanilla. LIGHT BLUE: 2 to 3 coats of Sky Blue followed with Vanilla then White to highlight. ORANGE: (sherbet on clown) 2 to 3 coats of Pumpkin followed with Vanilla to lighten.

REBASECOAT: Snowballs on snowball bears with Sky Blue. Paint Black to penguins and all bear noses.

DRYBRUSH: Snowballs with 3 to 4 coats of White. Drybrush penguins and bear noses lightly with Confederate Gray. Paint penguins beaks with Bright Orange, drybrush with Bright Orange and Vanilla mixed.

PAINT: Water Base Gold to all gold areas, Water Base Silver to all silver areas. Paint Pumpkin mixed with Vanilla to swirl on suckers and paint Christmas Red in between yellow and orange swirl. Paint Gold Dust Glimmerz over gold areas as desired for more sparkle. Paint Regency Gold Glitter It to carolers, angel bears, our first Christmas bears and anywhere you would like a little gold sparkle. Ruby Glitter It was used on the roses and red areas of our first Christmas bears. Magic Potion Glitter It was used on the lover bears. Paint Baby Kisses to ballerina's costume. Paint Yellow Chiffon to trim on clown bears and yellow area of sucker. Paint Peach Blossom Shimmers to sherbet and orange swirl on sucker. Paint Black to soldiers as shown, when dry paint Clear Gloss Sealer for shine. Gingerbread trim is painted using Dark Blond. Paint all eyes using Electric Blue for the irises.

PLAIN CARD ORNAMENTS AND ENVELOPES

Materials Needed

OPAQUE STAINS: Deep Brown, Burgundy, Christmas Red, Night Blue, Vanilla and Water Base Gold.

GLIMMERZ: Gold Dust.

MISC.: Photos, old Christmas cards etc.

BASECOAT: Envelopes with Deep Brown.

DRYBRUSH: Red envelopes with 2 coats of Burgundy followed with 2 to 3 coats of Christmas Red. Blue envelope with 2 coats of Night Blue followed with Electric Blue and Vanilla mixed, highlight with Vanilla.

PAINT: Using a new pencil eraser paint dots of Gold Dust to red envelope.

Paint Regency Gold Glitter It to blue envelope.

CARDS: Glue photos or picture cut outs to painted cards as shown and decorate as desired using Glimmerz and other glittery products. The cards are also great for china painting and other hand painting techniques and designs.
