MATERIALS NEEDED

OPAQUE STAINS: Baby Blue, Light Turquoise, Northern Blue, Bright Blue, Christmas Green, Bright Green, Medium Green, Dark Yellow, Curry, Fire Thorn, Bright Red, Persimmon, Orange Peel, Holly Green, Concord, Purple, Pansy, Butterscotch, Clove, Rust, Burnt Orange, Magenta, Light Pink, Charcoal, Ash, Black Brown, Saddle Brown, Ivory, White and Black.

TRANSLUCENT STAINS: Tan Sparkle

ULTRA METALLICS: Silver and Gold

MISC: Electrical hookups, Medium Globe Lights and 7mm Globe Pin Lights

PREPARATION: After removing cast from the mold cut out all holes for stars, globe lights and electrical hookups. Cut out stars using Kemper punch tools as a guide. Slip attach garden stump snowman to log or garden stump if desired.

BASECOAT: Color to areas as follows: Blue Mix 1:3 Light Turquoise and Baby Blue – white areas, Curry – yellow areas, Persimmon – orange areas, Christmas Green – green areas, light cords – Holly Green, Concord – purple areas, Butterscotch – light brown areas, Northern Blue – blue areas, Clove – terra cotta pots, Fire Thorn – red areas, Magenta – pink areas, Silver – farmer's shovel and Black Brown to Snowballs for sale's log.

ANTIQUE: All pieces with Tan Sparkle, wipe off excess with a soft cloth.

DRYBRUSH: As follows: **Blue Mix areas** – 2 to 3 coats of the Blue Mix followed with 3 to 4 coats of White. **Yellow areas** – 1 to 2 coats of Curry followed with 1 to 2 coats of Dark Yellow followed with 1 to 2 coats of White added to your brush. **Orange areas** – 2 coats of Persimmon followed with 2 coats of Orange Peel, highlight with White added to your brush. **Green areas** – 2 to 3 coats of Christmas Green followed with 1 to 2 coats of Bright Green, 1 to 2 coats of Medium Green and 1 to 2 coats of Dark Yellow added to your brush.

Light cords – 1 to 2 coats of Holly Green, highlight with White added to your brush. Purple areas – 1 to 2 coats of Concord, 1 to 2 coats of Pansy and 1 to 2 coats of Purple, highlight with White added to your brush. Light brown areas – 2 coats of Butterscotch followed with 2 to 3 coat of Ivory added to your brush. Blue areas – 2 to 3 coats of Northern Blue followed with 2 to 3 coats of Bright Blue, continue with 2 to 3 coats of White added to your brush. Terra cotta pots – 2 coats of Clove followed with 2 to 3 coats of Rust and 2 coats of Burnt Orange, highlight with a coat of Butterscotch. Red areas – 2 to 3 coats of Fire Thorn, 2 to 3 coats of Bright Red and 2 coats of Persimmon added to your brush. Pink areas – 2 to 3 coats of Magenta followed with 2 coats of Light Pink added to your brush, highlight lightly with White. Drybrush shovel with silver. Drybrush Snowballs for sale log with Black Brown followed with Saddle Brown and then Butterscotch.

PAINT: Black to all black areas of Penguins, drybrush these areas lightly and evenly with Charcoal and Ash. Buckles on overalls and trim on shovel with Bright Gold. Paint eyes using Bright Blue for the irises (**for detailed instructions on painting eyes, check out our eye painting pictorial on our website** <u>www.claymagicinc.com</u>). Paint words on signs, tags and pots as desired.

MATERIALS NEEDED

OPAQUE STAINS: Black Brown, Saddle Brown, Butterscotch, Ivory, Baby Blue, Turquoise, White, Charcoal, Ash and Cobblestone.

PREPARATION: After removing cast from mold cut out stump for use with a candle or pot (can be cut out to fit a 6" terra cotta pot) or slip attach "Let It Snow" log slice. Cut out log planter for use as a card holder. If desired slip attach Garden Stump Snowman to log or garden stump. Cut out stars in snowman's hat and scarf as shown using the Kemper star tool as a guide, place a hole for electrical.

BASECOAT: Garden Stump and log with Black Brown.

DRYBRUSH: Gray area of stump and log with 3 coats of Charcoal followed with 3 coats of Ash, highlight with 2 coats of Cobblestone. Brown areas of log and stump with 3 coats of Saddle Brown followed with 2 to 3 coat of Butterscotch, highlight with Ivory added to your brush. Highlight fungi with a couple extra coats of Ivory.

REBASECOAT: "Let it Snow" with the Blue Mix 3:1 Baby Blue and Turquoise.

DRYBRUSH: "Let it Snow" with 4 to 5 coats of White.
