

## **GHOST BEARS AND GHOST ON PUMPKIN**

### **Mold Numbers**

J-1540 Ghost on Pumpkin

### **Materials Needed**

**OPAQUE STAINS:** Deep Brown, Walnut, Medium Brown, Country Gold, Vanilla, Peach Blush, White, Bright Orange, Pumpkin, Marigold, Black Forest Green, Victorian Green, Autumn Rust and Black.

**SPECIALTIES:** Wrought Iron Fairy Dust.

**PREPARATION:** Slip attach any feet necessary and cut out any pumpkin faces desired while cast is still damp. Place any holes necessary for electrical.

Retexture textured seamlines with the TL-9 texture tool. Fire to cone 05.

**BASECOAT:** All pieces with Deep Brown.

**DRYBRUSH:** Bear's fur areas and all white areas with 3 to 4 coats of Walnut Brown followed with 2 to 3 coats of Medium Brown. Continue to drybrush bear fur areas only, with 1 to 2 very light coats of Country Gold. Lightly highlight bears fur with a small amount of Vanilla added in your brush. Blush cheeks with Peach Blush. With a fresh brush, drybrush white areas with 4 to 5 coats of Vanilla followed with 2 coats of White.

**REBASECOAT:** All pumpkins, string bows and stitches with Deep Brown.

**DRYBRUSH:** Pumpkins with 1 to 2 coats of Autumn Rust followed with 2 to 3 coats of Bright Orange. Continue with 1 to 2 coats of Pumpkin followed with a dab of Marigold and Vanilla in your brush to highlight. Blush pumpkin cheeks with Peach Blush. Drybrush string bows with Bright Orange followed with Pumpkin, highlight with Vanilla in your brush.

**REBASECOAT:** Pumpkin cord handles with Black and pumpkin stems with Deep Brown.

**DRYBRUSH:** Pumpkin cord handles with Confederate Gray. Pumpkin stems with Black Forest Green followed with Victorian Green.

**PAINT:** A Bright Orange stripe on the stitches using a 10/0 liner. Follow with a smaller and thinner stripe of Pumpkin. Using Wrought Iron Fairy Dust, paint to black areas of ghost costume and eyes and noses of pumpkins. When dry, rub the Wrought Iron Fairy Dust with your fingers to bring out the sparkles. Paint eyes and noses of the bears. Drybrush Confederate Gray to noses.

## **SCARECROW BEARS**

### **Mold number**

J-1547 Two Sm. Scarecrow bears

**Materials Needed**

**OPAQUE STAINS:** Deep Brown, Walnut, Medium Brown, County Gold, Vanilla, Night Blue, Sky Blue, Bright Orange, Pumpkin, Peach Blush, Dark Blond, Dark Forest Green, Victorian Green, Electric Blue, Turquoise, Black and White.

**BASECOAT:** Both pieces with Deep Brown.

**DRYBRUSH:** Drybrush bear fur areas, white clothing and pumkins the same as in the instructions for "Ghost Bears". Drybrush blue clothing as follows: 1 to 2 coats of Night Blue followed with 2 to 3 coats of Sky Blue.

**REBASECOAT:** Rope ties with Deep Brown. Using a fine liner or small brush, paint a slash of Medium Brown followed with Country Gold to rope as shown.

**PAINT:** Eyes and eyelashes using Electric Blue and Turquoise for the irises.
