MATERIALS NEEDED

OPAQUE STAINS: Ivory, White, Peach, Ultramarine, Soft Blue, Lake Blue, Bright Blue, Concord, Christmas Green, Medium Green, Curry, Dark Yellow, Magenta, Miami Pink, Bright Red, Persimmon, Saddle Brown, Butterscotch, Charcoal, Lilac, Sunflower and Black.

TRANSLUCENT STAINS: Pecan Sparkle and Tan Sparkle **LIQUID PEARLS:** Golden Ivory, White Mist, Golden Aqua and Golden Blue.

PREPARATION: After removing casts from molds, slip attach all necessary attachments and cut out areas desired. Place all holes in base for electrical. Allow to dry and clean greenware replacing textured seams using the TL-9 texture tool. Fire to cone 05.

BASECOAT: Color to areas as follows: **IVORY** – all white areas, **SUNFLOWER** – yellow egg of egg belly bunny, **CURRY** – to all other yellow areas, **LILAC** – to purple egg of egg belly bunny, **CONCORD** – to all other purple areas, **ULTRAMARINE** – to all blue areas, **BRIGHT RED** – to all red areas, **PERSIMMON** – to orange birdhouses, **MIAMI PINK** – to heart bellies of heart belly bunnies, **MAGENTA** – to all pink areas, **CHRISTMAS GREEN** – to all green areas, **SADDLE BROWN** – to straw birdhouses roofs, papa bunny's cane, mama's basket and "welcome" on welcome bunny.

ANTIQUE: Heart and Egg belly bunnies with Tan Sparkle and all other pieces with a 1:1 mix of Tan an Pecan Sparkle. Wipe off excess with a soft cloth.

DRYBRUSH: Color to areas as follows: **IVORY** – 2 to 3 coats to all White areas followed with 2 to 3 coats of **WHITE**, blush cheeks, insides of ears,

noses and pads of feet with a small amount of **PEACH** added to your brush. Drybrush egg and heart belly areas of bunnies with the original basecoat color followed with White added to your brush to highlight. **ULTRAMARINE** – 1 to 2 coats to all blue areas followed with 1 to 2 coats of **SOFT BLUE** and 1 to 2 coats of **LAKE BLUE**, add **WHITE** to your brush and add coats to lighten as desired. **CURRY** – 1 to 2 coats to all yellow areas followed with 1 to 2 coats of **DARK YELLOW**. Adding **WHITE** to your brush continue with 2 to 3 coats to lighten. **CONCORD** – 1 to 2 coats to purple areas, adding WHITE drybrush 3 to 4 coats to lighten and highlight. **MAGENTA** – 1 to 2 coats to all pink areas followed with 1 to 2 coats of MIAMI PINK, add WHITE to your brush to highlight. PERSIMMON – 1 to 2 coats to orange birdhouse, highlight with Ivory added to your brush. **BRIGHT RED** – 1 to 2 coats to all red areas, highlight with **PERSIMMON** added to your brush. CHRISTMAS GREEN - 1 to 2 coats to all areen areas. continue with 2 coats of **MEDIUM GREEN**, highlight lightly with WHITE added to your brush. **SADDLE BROWN** – 1 to 2 coats to straw birdhouse roofs, cane, basket and "welcome". Continue with 2 to 3 coats of **BUTTERSCOTCH** followed with **IVORY** added to your brush to highlight. Drybrush "welcome" with WHITE added to your brush.

PAINT: Eyes with Bright Blue for the irises. Paint buttons on Papa Bunny's coat with Liquid Pearls **GOLDEN IVORY**, and buttons on his shirt with **WHITE MIST**. Drybrush a 1:1 mix of **GOLDEN AQUA** and **GOLDEN BLUE** to Mama Bunny's ribbon and sleeve trim.

MATERIALS NEEDED

OPAQUE STAINS: Chocolate Fudge, Saddle Brown, Fire Thorn, Bright Red, Sherwood Dark, Rain Forest Green, Black Iris, Grape, Burgundy, Black, Charcoal and White. LIQUID PEARLS: Rich Ruby, Regency Purple and Black. MISC.: Paint on High Gloss Acrylic sealer. GLAZE: Clear Glaze OVERGLAZE: Hanovia Bright Gold METALLICS: Silver **PREPARATION:** Clean and slip attach desired hand attachments, clean to disguise attached area.

GLAZE: If desired carefully apply 3 to 4 coats of clear glaze to Vanessa's earrings and bracelet while in greenware, fire to cone 05. Clear glaze can also be applied to fired bisque also.

OVERGLAZE: Appy Hanovia Bright Gold to earrings and bracelet following manufactures instructions, fire to cone 017. BASECOAT: Apply dish soap to gold earrings and bracelet (eases in removing opaque stain when finished decorating) Basecoat all pieces with Chocolate Fudge.

DRYBRUSH: Flesh areas with 3 to 4 coats of Saddle Brown, blush cheeks and lips lightly with Burgundy added to your brush.

REBASECOAT: William and Vanessa's hair and hairdresser's dress and bouquet with Chocolate Fudge. Rebasecoat all other clothing areas with Black.

DRYBRUSH: Red areas as follows: 1 to 2 coats of Fire Thorn followed with 2 to 3 coats of Bright Red. Highlight lightly with Persimmon added to your brush. Drybrush stems and leaves on bouquet with Dark Sherwood followed with Rainforest Green. Drybrush purple areas with 1 to 2 coats of Grape. Drybrush sash on purple dress with Regency Purple Liquid Pearl drybrush her boots with Black Liquid Pearl. Blue areas with 1 to 2 coats of Black Iris. Drybrush black sash on black dress lightly with Charcoal.

PAINT: Red dress's collar, hair dryer and microphones with Black. Touch up any other black areas with Black. Paint eyes using Saddle Brown for the irises. Using a 725 Duncan liner, paint evenly placed uneven dots of High Gloss Acrylic to the entire black dress avoiding the sash and to the bodice of the purple dress. Paint Vanessa's fingernails with Bright Red; gloss with High Gloss Acrylic.

DRYBRUSH: Hairdryer screen with Silver. Drybrush black boots, shoes, collar, hair dryer and hair with High Gloss Acrylic. Paint handle to microphone with High Gloss Acrylic.

FINISH: Soften paint on earrings and bracelet with water on a small drybrush, lightly scrub paint loose from overglaze.
