PREPARATION: While casts are still damp cut out the zombies as pictured. Let dry, clean and fire to cone 04.

BASECOAT: Flesh areas: with Dew Drop Blue and Country Sage. Apply color to different areas while blending the colors. **Brown areas:** Chocolate Fudge. **White areas:** Med. Mocha. **Blue areas:** with a mix of Black and Rich Blue. Use Rich Blue with Black added a little at a time until you get a nice Navy Blue color. **Worms** in Terra Cotta.

ANTIQUE: With Golden Buckskin, wipe off excess with a soft cloth.

DRYBRUSH: With several brushes, drybrush the flesh with Dew drop Blue and Country Sage. Add Light Taupe to your brushes and blend the colors as youdrybrush. White areas: With Med. Mocha, Light Taupe, Buttermilk and highlight with White. Blue Areas: Navy mix, Rich Blue and highlight with Dew Drop Blue and White. Brown Areas: Chocolate Fudge, Chocolate, Med. Mocha and highlight with Golden Ochre. Worms with Terra Cotta, Orange Rust, Orange and highlight with Brightest Yellow. Drybrush eyes with Buttermilk and White. SHADE: Using watered down Antique Red and a dab of Chocolate Fudge, lightly shade around eyes, shirt collars, or where desired. Lightly paint all open wounds and the heart tattoo. Using watered down white paint the ribbon on the heart. PAINT: Soles of the shoes Black, irises are Dew Drop Blue. Line the eyes with a dark Gray.

PREPARATION: While casts are still damp cut out as desired. Clean and fire to cone 04.

BASECOAT: Pumpkins- Terra Cotta, **Stems-**Chocolate Fudge, **leaves-**Med. Mocha and **worms-**Forest Green.

ANTIQUE: With Golden Buckskin, wipe off excess with soft cloth.

DRYBRUSH: Pumpkins- Terra Cotta, Orange Rust, Orange, and highlight with a couple coats of Brightest Yellow and then lightly highlight with Buttermilk. **Stems** - with Chocolate Fudge, Chocolate, Med. Mocha, and Golden Ochre. Highlight lightly with Buttermilk. **Leaves-**with 1 Coat Med. Mocha, and a mix of

3:1 Forest Green and Med. Mocha, 3 to 4 coats to leaves. Highlight edges of leaves with Golden Ochre added to your brush. **Worms**-Forest Green, Country Sage, Limeburst and highlight with a couple of coats of Brightest Yellow. **Pumpkin seeds** -Buttermilk and White. Paint Ladybug bodies with Chocolate Fudge and drybrush with Antique Red and Christmas Red, highlight with Orange. **SHADE:** Shade stems and leaves with Black and the pumpkin bodies with Chocolate Fudge. Paint eyes with Dew Drop Blue for the irises.

HAUNTED MANSION AND BASE MOLD NUMBERS

PREPARATION: While cast is still damp cut out mansion as desired. Clean and fire to cone 04.

BASECOAT: Both pieces with Chocolate Fudge.

DRYBRUSH: 2 coats of Chocolate to both pieces. Drybrush lighter areas of the mansion with Chocolate, Med. Mocha, Golden Ochre and Buttermilk. **Red areas-**Antique Red and Christmas Red. **Purple areas-**Purple mix and highlight with White. (refer to fairy house instructions for mix ratio) **Green areas-**Country Sage, Limeburst and highlight with White. **Brick areas-**Terra Cotta and highlight with a little Orange here and there. Highlight lightly with Buttermilk. Drybrush the grassy areas and bottom of the base with Med. Mocha. Continue the grassy areas with the green mix and highlight with Golden Ochre. **Stones-**Med. Mocha, purple mix and Med. Gray. (Refer to fairy house base for drybrushing instructions)

PAINT: Black areas on mansion with Black. Drybrush with a mix of Med. Gray and Black.

SHADE: If desired, shade both pieces with Black.
