SCARECROWS AND BIRDHOUSE PUMPKINS

PREPARATION: While cast is still damp cut out windows in cider mill, cut out desired design on plain scarecrows. Cut out windows and doors on birdhouse pumpkins and cut out any stars and moons as desired. Place holes directly through the piece at both sides of the cat and dog birdhouse post and on one side of the Harvest Birdhouse Post to tie a raffia bow completely around the birdhouse post as shown. (Be sure these holes line up) Place all holes for electrical. Slip attach leaves to birdhouse roofs and welcome and plain signs. Allow to dry and clean and fire to cone 04.

BASECOAT: Color to areas as follows: **Medium Taupe** – flesh areas. **Brick Red** – all orange areas. **Navy** – Dark Blue areas. **Med. Blue** – Boy scarecrow's sky area. **Yellow Green** – Lighter green areas. **Forest Green** – Darker green areas. **Medium Mocha** – Scarecrows hair. **Golden Ochre** – yellow areas. **Old World Santa** – Red areas. **Slate Gray** – Cider Mill, Cat and Dog gray areas. **Black** – black/Brown areas. **Chocolate Fudge** – Acorns and pumpkin stems. **Buttermilk** – Cat and dog white areas and small gourd on Harvest Pumpkin.

ANTIQUÉ: Using a 1:1 mix of Ginny Tan Twinkle and Golden Buckskin Twinkle antique all pieces, wipe off excess with a soft cloth.

DRYBRUSH: Drybrush approximately 2 coats per color, allow drying in between coats. Drybrush 2 to 3 different areas at one time allowing colors to dry while working on other areas. **Flesh areas** – Medium Taupe, Medium Portrait. Blush cheeks and noses with a small amount of Brick Red and Orange added to your brush. **Scarecrows hair** – Medium Brown, Golden Ochre and Buttermilk. **Dark Blue Areas** – Navy, Dark Blue, Turquoise, Light Blue and White. Refer to picture. **Scarecrow boy's sky area**- Med. Blue and Turquoise, highlight with Light Blue and White. **Yellow areas** –Golden Ocher, Honey Toast, Brightest Yellow, Bright Yellow and Buttermilk. **Light Green areas** – Yellow Green, Limeburst and Brightest Yellow. **Dark Green areas** – Forest Green, Country Sage and Limeburst. **Orange areas** – Brick Red, Terra Cotta, Orange Rust, Orange, Brightest Yellow and a small amount of Buttermilk. **Red areas** – Old World Santa, Antique Red, Red and Orange. To brighten up tips of leaves drybrush Brightest Yellow, allow to dry and drybrush over with Red. Add Orange and Brightest Yellow to leaves as desired. **Cider Mill** – Slate Gray, Medium Gray and Light Gray, highlight lightly with a small amount of White added to your brush. **Cat and dog white areas** – Buttermilk, highlight with White.

PAINT: Paint centers of sunflowers with Black. Centers of the Black-Eyed-Susan's with Chocolate Fudge. Paint ears and nose on dog and nose on cat with Flat Black. Drybrush these black areas with Slate Gray and Med. Gray. Paint eyes as shown.

DRYBRUSH: Cider Mill roof and Scarecrow shoes with Black, continue shoes and roof and centers of Sunflowers with Chocolate Fudge. Continue shoes, roof and centers of sunflowers and centers of Black eyed Susan's with Chocolate and continue all but the roof with Golden Ochre.

SHADE: Where desired with Chocolate Fudge and Flat Black.

PUMPKIN STACKS

MOLD NUMBERS

3015 Pumpkin Stack 17”T x 8”W \$108.00

PREPARATION: After removing casts from molds, place holes for spiders, draw spider legs in clay and cut out as shown or desired, place all holes for electrical. Allow to dry, clean greenware and fire to cone 04.

BASECOAT: Avoiding the interior of the pumpkins, basecoat with Chocolate Fudge.

DRYBRUSH: All pieces with 2 coats of Chocolate, continue pumpkin stems with 1 to 2 coats of Medium Mocha followed with Light Umber and Golden Ochre. Highlight with Buttermilk added to your brush. With a fresh brush, drybrush 2 to 3 coats of Brick Red to Pumpkins followed with 2 to 3 coats of Orange. Highlight pumpkins with Honey Toast added to your brush; 1 to 2 coats; further highlight by adding Brightest Yellow to your brush. Blush cheeks on pumpkin stack with a small amount of Brick Red and Orange added to your brush.

REBASECOAT: Pumpkin leaves where necessary with Chocolate Fudge.

DRYBRUSH: Drybrush pumpkin leaves with 2 to 3 coats of Artichoke followed with Golden Ocher added to your brush.

PAINT: Eyes using Rich Blue for the irises. Shade as desired with Black.

MAYCO STROKE AND COATS USED ON THIS FLYER: SC-27 Sour Apple, SC-15 Tuxedo, SC-86Old Lace, SC-48 Camel Back, SC- 23 Jack –O’-Lantern, SC-52 Toad-aly Green, SC-26 Green Thumb, SC-75 Orange-a-Peel, SC-74 Hot Tamale, SC-6 Sunkissed, SC-2 Melon- Choly and SC-16 Cotton Tail.

GLAZE: C-109 Wonder Clear Dipping

MAYCO BRUSHES: #4 CB-604, #8CB-618 Soft Fan, #6 CB106 Script Liner, 10.0 CB-110 Mini Liner and CB-200 Detail

PREPARATION: Place holes in leaves for stringing. Attach acorns to leaves as desired.

Using appropriate size fan brushes APPLY STROKE AND COAT: Mix water with Camel Back to a heavy cream consistency; **apply to all 04 bisque.** Using a sponge and rinsing the sponge often, wipe paint away leaving color in crevices as shown.

CAT AND DOG: Mix water with Old Lace to a heavy cream consistency, apply one even coat to cat and dog. Continue the dog’s brown areas with one heavy cream consistency coat of Camel Back and orange areas of Cat with one thinned down coat of Jack O’ Lantern. Paint the dog’s lower lip with Melon-Choly. Paint stripes on cat with Camel Back. Paint black areas with 2 coats of Tuxedo. Paint eyes with Tuxedo and line as shown.

LEAVES: Thinning all color to a light cream consistency apply one coat of color to leaves using the various colors. Red leaves – Hot Tamale, Orange a Peel, Sunkissed. Green Leaves – Sour Apple, Toad-aly Green, Green Thumb. Brown Leaves – Camel Back, Sunkissed. Acorns with Camel Back, add a touch of Orange or Green to nut.

DIP: Dip into Clear Dipping and fire to cone 06.
