

## **SCARECROWS**

### **Materials Needed**

**OPAQUE STAINS:** Chocolate Fudge, Hot Orange, Persimmon, Orange Peel, Creole Spice, Fire Thorn, Barnyard Red, Bright Red, Black Iris, Northern Blue, Concord, Tangelo, Purple, Bright Blue, Curry, Gold, Dark Yellow, Ivory, White, Sherwood Dark, Rainforest Green, Medium Green, Lemon Grass, Saddle Brown, Butterscotch, Black and White.

**GLAZE:** IN 1030 Cornmeal

**MISC.:** Electrical hookups

**PREPARATION:** After removing casts from mold, cut out stars in scarecrow light and scarecrow post. Cut out “love loft” window and place all holes necessary in items and bases for lighting. Allow to dry, clean greenware and fire to cone 04.

**GLAZE:** if desired glaze inside of scarecrow light with Cornmeal, clean up all drips and inside of stars and holes before firing. Follow manufactures instructions for application and firing.

**BASECOAT:** All items with Chocolate Fudge. When basecoating using an airbrush be sure to stuff the items that will light up with newspaper before airbrushing so the inside remains unpainted bisque to reflect light better.

**DRYBRUSH: NOTE:** After each drybrush color such as “orange” rebasecoat the next area with Chocolate fudge before beginning the next drybrush color. **Drybrush Orange** areas with 2 coats of Hot Orange, continue with 2 coats of Persimmon and 2 coats of Orange Peel, highlight with Ivory added to your brush. Drybrush garden stump scarecrow’s shirt, base to scarecrow light and gloved hands of scarecrows with 2 coats of Saddle Brown followed with 2 coats of Butterscotch, highlight with Ivory added to your brush. **Drybrush yellow** areas with 2 coats of Curry followed with 2 coats of Gold then Ivory and then White added to your brush to highlight. **Drybrush green** areas with Sherwood Dark followed with 2 coats of Rainforest Green and 2 coats of Medium Green, highlight with Lemon Grass. **Drybrush blue** areas with 2 coats of the following colors, Black Iris, Northern Blue, highlight with Bright Blue and then Ivory added to your brush. **Drybrush red** areas with 2 coats of the following colors, Creole Spice, Fire Thorn, Barnyard Red. To brighten red areas continue drybrushing these areas with 2 coats of Bright Red followed with Persimmon added to your brush to

highlight. Drybrush patches and buttons on scarecrow using Persimmon, Concord and Rainforest Green, highlight patches and buttons with Orange Peel, Purple and Medium Green adding Ivory to each to highlight. Paint noses and cheek with Tangelo, drybrush with Tangelo and Ivory.

**PAINT:** Eyes using Bright Blue for the irises. Paint all words and patch detail as shown.

### **MATERIALS NEEDED**

**OPAQUE STAINS:** Chocolate Fudge, Saddle Brown, Black, Charcoal, Hot Orange, Persimmon, Orange Peel, Grape, Concord, Sherwood Dark, Avocado, Medium Green, Lemon Grass, Curry, Dark Yellow, Ivory, White, Peach, Rainforest Green, Purple, Cinnamon, Burnt Orange, Rust, Olive Moss, Bright Blue and Black.

**BASECOAT:** All pieces with Chocolate Fudge.

**DRYBRUSH: NOTE:** After each drybrush color such as “orange” rebasecoat the next area with Chocolate Fudge before beginning the next drybrush color. Drybrush color to areas as follows: **GREEN GHOSTS** and green areas of mummy: 2 to 3 coats of Avocado followed with 2 coats of Medium Green and 2 to 3 coats of Lemon Grass, blush cheeks with Peach. **YELLOW AREAS** – 2 to 3 coats of Curry followed with 2 coats of Dark Yellow, highlight with Ivory added to your brush. I love you punkin thought bubble with 4 coats of Ivory, highlight lightly with White. **PURPLE SIGNS AND PURPLE AREA OF MUMMY** – with 2 coats of Grape followed with 2 coats of Concord, 2 coats of Purple, highlight with Ivory and then White added to your brush. Drybrush mummy’s frog with Rainforest Green followed with Avocado and then Medium Green. Drybrush worm with Cinnamon followed with Rust and Burnt Orange. Paint head stones with Black, drybrush lightly with Charcoal. Drybrush base of ghost with moon with Olive Moss. Drybrush I love you punkin base, leaves and stems with Sherwood Dark followed with Rainforest Green, Avocado, and Medium Green. Drybrush ghost for hire and bootiful day ghost’s base with Avocado, Medium Green, highlight lightly with Lemon Grass added to your brush. Drybrush light cord and leaves with Avocado, highlight with Ivory. Drybrush sign posts with Saddle Brown.

**PAINT:** Eyes with Bright Blue for the irises. Paint words on signs, faces on pumpkins and black areas of thought bubble.

### **Materials Needed**

**OPAQUE STAINS:** Black, Chocolate Fudge, Walnut, Saddle Brown, Hot Orange, Persimmon, Orange Peel, Curry, Dark Yellow, Grape, Concord, Avocado, Christmas Green, Medium Green, Lemon Grass, Peach, Charcoal, Olive Moss, Bright Red, Black Iris, Confederate Blue, Bright Blue, Black and White.

**GLAZE:** CR 914 Grape Splash

**PREPARATION:** After removing cast from mold cut out Ghost Post as shown, place proper holes in base for lighting. Slip attach witch’s shoe to the top of the plain box lid for a knob. Clean and fire greenware to cone 04.

**GLAZE:** Inside of stump box and lid with Grape Splash, follow manufactures instructions for application and firing.

**BASECOAT:** All pieces with Black. When basecoating using an airbrush, be sure to stuff the items that will light up with newspaper before airbrushing so the inside remains unpainted bisque to reflect light better.

**DRYBRUSH:** Color to areas as follows: 1 to 2 coats of **Chocolate Fudge** followed by **Walnut** - brown areas of stump box and lids and grape vines. Continue grape vines with Saddle Brown. 2 coats of Hot Orange followed with 2 coats of Persimmon - **All orange areas**. Excluding witch’s hat band continue all orange areas with 2 coats of Orange Peel, highlight with Ivory added to your brush. 1 to 2 coats of Christmas Green followed with 2 coats of Avocado - **all green areas**. Continue green areas of stump with Medium Green, highlight lightly with Lemon Grass added to your brush. Highlight grape leaves with Medium Green and love shack sign with Medium Green and Dark Yellow. Continue witch’s skin with 1 coat of Lemon Grass and ghosts and web with 2

coats of Medium Green followed with 3 coats of Lemon Grass, blush ghost's cheeks with Peach. 2 to 3 coats of Dark yellow to yellow areas add Ivory to your brush to lighten. Drybrush "Go Back" sign with a light swipe of Medium Green. 1 to 2 coats of Grape followed with 2 coats of Concord followed with Ivory added to your brush to highlight – all purple areas. Drybrush head stones with Charcoal. Drybrush ghost post base with Olive Moss 2 to 3 coats.

**PAINT:** Stripes to witch's socks and fingernails with Bright Red. Paint witch's tooth and tips of candy corn with White. Paint detail on shoes as shown. Paint eyes using Bright Blue for the irises.

## **HAPPY HARVEST GARDEN STUMP**

### **Mold Numbers**

**2544 Happy Harvest Log Slice/Stump Att. 6.75"W \$22.00**

### **Materials Needed**

**OPAQUE STAINS:** Chocolate Fudge, Saddle Brown, Butterscotch, Ivory, Charcoal, Ash, Grey, Creole Spice, Bright Red, Persimmon, Medium Green and Lemon Peel.

**BASECOAT:** Stump and log slice with Chocolate Fudge.

**DRYBRUSH:** Brown area of stump with 2 to 3 coats of Saddle Brown followed with 2 to 3 coats of Butterscotch, highlight with Ivory added to your brush.

**BASECOAT:** Grey area of stump with Charcoal.

**DRYBRUSH:** Grey areas of stump with Ash followed with Grey, highlight with White added to your brush.

**BASECOAT:** HAPPY HARVEST with Chocolate Fudge.

**DRYBRUSH:** HAPPY HARVEST with 2 to 3 coats of Creole Spice followed with Bright Red, highlight with Persimmon added to your brush.

**APPLY GREEN WASH:** Mix 1:1 Lemon Peel and Medium Green, add three parts water, mix well. The mixture should still be opaque but very watery. Apply to items over a sink with the water running. Apply paint mixture using a fan brush full strength, using your fan brush retrieve water from the running tap and apply on top of the green mixture adding more water and more paint as you move along the piece. The water and paint should flow freely. Some areas of the logs and stumps will have more green paint left behind as shown. Allow to dry undisturbed.
