#### MATERIALS NEEDED

MAYCO ASTRO GEMS: AS-510 White Opal, AS-513 Golden Sand, AS-532 Turquoise, AS-523 Gray Granite and AS-545 Purple Quartz. MAYCO STROKE AND COATS: SC-16 Cotton Tail, SC-15 Tuxedo, SC-60 Silver Lining, SC- 2 Melon Choly, SC-6 Sunkissed and SC-42 Butter Me Up. MAYCO ONE STROKES: OS-28 Buttercup, OS-32 Shamrock Green, OS-34 Sienna Brown, OS-47 Purple, OS-38 Yuma Turquoise and OS-1 Mirror Black. MAYCO BRUSHES USED: AB-834 <sup>3</sup>/<sub>4</sub>"Basecoat, RB-138 3/8"Angled Shader, Various size RB and size 4, 6 & 8 round CB brushes, 10/0 Mini Liner CB 110, Script Liner CB 106, #4 Soft Fan CB-604, UB and round AB Drybrushes.

DESIGN: Butterfly and flower cut outs using the butterfly or flower template available from our website in the stencil section. To make a mirror image of a name or design on the wings of the butterfly, draw name or design onto left wing template, using the same template flip over on the opposite wing and draw on the reverse to cut out.

NOTE: AFTER REMOVING CASTS FROM MOLD, CUT OUT AS DESIRED. (download words; Faith, Jesus and Love for the cross) letters, numbers and bug stencils from our website. Slip attach add on's as desired. Place a hole in the back for a pinch socket. Allow to Dry. Carefully clean greenware and fire to cone 04. Be extremely aware of the cut out area and any fragile add on's, especially in the greenware stage, all your work can fall apart from one misplaced thumb.

**APPLY ASTRO GEMS:** Using a #4 soft fan brush, apply 3 coats of Astro Gem to the bisque as follows using manufacturers instructions:

**FLOWER** - White Opal – white area of flower. Turquoise – back, sides and edges of flower as shown.

**BUTTERFLY – Mix 3:1 White Opal and Purple Quartz.** From the bottom up on the face of the butterfly begin with Purple Quartz and blend the purple and white mix and then White Opal. White Opal – to the sides, back and edges of the butterfly as shown. Gray Granite – butterfly's body

**CROSS – Mix 3:1 Golden Sand and Turquoise**. From the bottom up on all sides of the cross, blend the Astro Gems with the following in this order.

Turquoise, Turquoise and Golden Sand mix, Golden Sand and White Opal. **Gray Granite** – butterfly's body.

# APPLY STROKE AND COATS – two coats of Tuxedo and 3 coats of all other colors.

FLOWER, BUTTERFLY AND CROSS: Mix 1:1 Sunkissed and Butter Me Up, apply yellow mix to flower centers and yellow stripes on bee. Paint flower petals and butterfly wings with Cotton Tail. Using a sponge, allowing to dry in between coats, apply blush to smiley face using Melon Choly. Paint bee's wings with Silver lining and bee's body's with Tuxedo.

**APPLY ONE STROKE:** Shade "Meg" with Purple, "Faith" with Yuma Turquoise and the sunrise on the cross with Buttercup. Using simple brush strokes, paint grass, flower stem and leaf with Shamrock and Sienna Brown. Line as shown using Mirror Black and Pearl Gray One Stroke. For a shinier finish on the Stroke and Coat areas, apply one coat of clear glaze. Fire to cone 06.

# MATERIALS NEEDED

MAYCO STROKE AND COAT: SC-1 Pink-A-Boo, SC-70 Pink A Dot, SC-16 Cotton Tail, SC-14 Java Bean, SC-45 My Blue Heaven, SC-74 Hot Tamale, SC-3 Wine About It, SC-11 Blue Yonder, SC-60 Silver Lining, SC-75 Orange A Peel, SC-33 Fruit Of The Vine, SP-253 Speckled Purple Haze, SP-216 Speckled Cotton Tail, SP-231 Speckled The Blues.

# Apply Stroke and Coats with #4 Soft Fan CB-604 and/or Script Liner CB 106 and mini liner or small detail brushes for the very small areas and eyes.

**SNOWMEN:** Three coats of My Blue Heaven on snowmen blue bellies, allow to dry. Using a snowflake punch, take the snowflake and dampen, lay snowflake on snowman belly and even out. Apply 2 coats of Cotton Tail to all white areas of snowman, including over the paper snowflake. Before the second coat of Cotton Tail dries completely remove the paper snowflake using a straight pin or exacto blade tip. Snowmen shown using Speckled Cotton Tail, Speckled My Blue Heaven and Speckled The Blues for their hats and mittens. Noses are Orange A Peel. Blush cheeks with 3 sponged on coats of Melon Choly, allowing the color to dry between coats. Line with Tuxedo.

**KITTENS:** Two coats of Cotton Tail to the entire piece. Apply 1 coat of Speckled Purple Haze using the script liner as shown for the kitten's stripes. Apply 2 coats of Pink A Dot to pink areas. Paint eyes using Blue yonder for the irises. Line with Tuxedo.

**PUPPIES**: Two coats of Cotton Tail to the entire piece. Paint gray areas with 3 coats of Gray Hare, pink areas with 3 coats of Pink A Dot. Black areas with 2 coats of Tuxedo, brown areas with 2 coats of Java Bean. Paint irises of the eyes with either Blue Yonder or Java Bean. Line with Tuxedo.

**CUPCAKES:** Two coats of Cotton Tail to white areas, 4 coats of Pink A Dot to cupcake bottom and 4 coats of Pink A Boo to cupcake top. Blue cupcake bottom is 3 coats of My Blue Heaven. 3 coats of Java Bean to brown cupcake top. Three coats of Hot Tamale to cherry. Paint on sprinkles using Fruit Of The Vine, Orange A Peel, Hot Tamale, My Blue Heaven, Sour Apple, Butter Me Up and Cotton Tail.

DIP: Dip pieces in Mayco's Clear Blu dipping. Fire to cone 06.

### MATERIALS NEEDED

MAYCO OPAQUE STAINS: SS-135 White, SS-45 Buttermilk, SS-138 Flat Black, SS-132 Slate Gray, SS-130 Medium Gray, SS-151 Rich Rose, SS-108 Light Gray, SS-335 Rich Blue, MAYCO TRANLSUCENTS: TL-309 Golden Buckskin Twinkle and TL-310 Ginny Tan Twinkle

After removing cast from mold, cut out as desired. Cut a hole for a pinch socket if you plan on lighting or a coin slot for a bank. Allow to dry, clean greenware and fire to cone 04.

### BASECOAT: With Slate Gray.

**ANTIQUE:** With Golden Buckskin Twinkle, wipe off excess with a soft cloth, remember to antique inside letters, remove excess from cut outs carefully with a brush.

**DRYBRUSH:** Kittens with 2 heavy coats of Slate Gray, followed with 2 heavy coats of Medium Gray and then Light Gray. Highlight with Buttermilk and then White. Blush insides of ears, pads of feet and noses with Rich Rose, highlight with White.

PAINT: Stripes to Kitten using the script liner with one coat of White. Paint eyes using Rich Blue for the irises. Line stripes with Black. Shade stripes an all areas with Flat Black.

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
