## **MATERIALS NEEDED**

**UNDERGLAZE:** Powder Blue, Silver Gray, Cottage Brown, Cocoa Brown, Sandalwood, Jade Green and Cobalt Black.

**BISQUE UNDERGLAZE:** Bright Blush, Light Scarlet, Light Wine, Bright Briarwood, Bright Taupe, Dark Wine, Dark Salsa, Dark Taupe and Bright Gray.

**GLAZE**: Yadro

**OVERGLAZE:** Hanovia Gold

**UNDERGLAZE:** Apply underglazee to either greenware or bisque following manufacturers instructions. NOTE: All white cloth and base areas will remain bisque so you will want to be neat with the underglaze that surround these areas. Apply color to areas as follows: COTTAGE BROWN – Black flesh, brown hair, white Joseph's wrap and basket, black Joseph's bottle and rock base on ascending Jesus'. POWDER BLUE – to white Mary's veil and dress and bottle. Black Mary's veil and black Joseph's wrap, black Mary's cape and the box and basket on base. Black Madonna's under dress. SANDALWOOD – to hay on manger. COCOA – to staffs and mangers. JADE GREEN – to grass on base. 3:1 mix of COTTAGE BROWN AND COBALT BLACK – Black Joseph's beard and black Mary's hair. Black ascending Jesus' hair. Fire to cone 05.

**BISQUE UNDERGLAZE:** Paint hair to babies, eyes, eyebrows and lips to figurines as follows: BLACK FIGURINES: Paint eyes and nipples with Dark Taupe and eyebrows with a 1:1 mix of Dark Taupe and Bright Grey, lips with 2:1 mix of Light Wine and Dark Wine, add a little Dark Salsa and Bright Grey. Apply a light wash of Dark Taupe to baby Jesus' scalp. WHITE FIGURINES: Eyes and eyebrows same as the black figurines. Lips use a 1:1 mix of Bright Blush and Light Scarlet adding a small amount of Light Wine. Apply a light wash of Bright Briarwood to baby's scalp. Allow to dry.

**GLAZE:** Glaze all pieces with 3 flowing and even coats of Yadro. Be sure you leave no drips or lumps. Fire to cone 06.

**OVERGLAZE:** Apply Hanovia Gold to all areas desired to be gold, fire to cone 017. Fire to manufacturers instructions.
