PREPARATION: After removing casts from molds place all holes and stars as desired for lighting electrical and lighting. Cut out design as desired in Large Plain Tree. Allow to dry, clean and fire to cone 04.

BLUE SANTAS AND TREE

BASECOAT: SANTAS: Medium Taupe – flesh. Buttermilk – all white areas. Chocolate Fudge – brown areas. Accent Green – trees, bushes and green area of large tree with scene. Navy – blue areas, snowmen, roof top and snow areas. Blue Mix 1:1 Sky Blue and Light Blue

ANTIQUE: With a 1:1 mix of Ginny Tan Twinkle and Golden Buckskin Twinkle, wipe off excess with a soft cloth.

DRYBRUSH: Drybrush Medium Taupe to Santa's face followed with a light coat or two of Medium Portrait, blush cheeks and nose lightly with Coral Rose. Drybrush Buttermilk areas with 2 to 3 coats of Buttermilk followed with 1 to 2 coats of White, apply 2 extra drybrush coats to Santa's beard and mustache. Drybrush the blue sky areas with Navy followed with Dark Blue. Adding White to your brush lightly highlight the texture on the sky. Drybrush the snowmen and snow areas with 2 heavy coats of Navy, follow with 2 coats of dark blue, continue with 2 coats of the blue mix. Adding white to your brush, drybrush 2 to 3 coats or until desired effect is achieved. Drybrush trees with Accent Green followed with Forest Green, highlight lightly with Country Sage. Drybrush brown areas with Chocolate Fudge followed with Chocolate, Medium Mocha, highlight lightly with Light Umber. Paint snowmen hats and scarves as desired. Drybrush stars with Shimmering Silver.

WHITE SANTAS AND TREE (and Santa Ornaments)

BASECOAT: SANTAS: Medium Taupe – flesh. Buttermilk – all white areas.

Chocolate Fudge – House, mittens and shoes and tree trunks, Chocolate –
Brown Trim on coats and hats, Accent Green – trees and bushes.

Wedgewood Blue – to inside Mrs. Santa's hood, snowmen, and snow areas. (Old World Santa – Hats on Santa ornaments)

ANTIQUE: With a 1:1 mix of Ginny Tan Twinkle and Golden Buckskin Twinkle, wipe off excess with a soft cloth.

DRYBRUSH: Drybrush Medium Taupe to Santa's face followed with a light coat or two of Medium Portrait, blush cheeks and nose lightly with Coral Rose. Drybrush Buttermilk areas with 2 to 3 coats of Buttermilk followed with 1 to 2 coats of White, apply 2 extra drybrush coats to Santa's beard and mustache. Drybrush blue area with Wedgewood followed with two coats of **Blue Mix 1:1 Turquoise and Light Blue.** Add White to your brush and continue to drybrush snow and snowmen to desired lightness. Drybrush trees with Accent Green followed with Forest Green, highlight lightly with Country Sage. Drybrush Chocolate Fudge areas with Chocolate Fudge followed lightly with Chocolate areas with

Chocolate. Continue these areas and continue the house and tree trunks with Medium Mocha. Highlight house, tree trunks and lighter squares on coat and hat trim lightly with Light Umber followed with Buttermilk. Paint snowmen hats and scarves as desired or shown. Drybrush stars with Emperors Gold. (Drybrush Old World Santa to ornament hat, continue with Christmas Red)

PAINT: Paint eyes on ornament using Rich Blue for the irises, paint all other eyes and buttons Flat Black. Paint bare tree with Chocolate Fudge. Shade as desired using Medium Mocha. Glue in lights and apply Mayco's non fired snow as desired.

All signs with Buttermilk.

ANTIQUE: With a 1:1 mix of Ginny Tan Twinkle and Golden Buckskin Twinkle, wipe off excess with a soft cloth.

DRYBRUSH: Triple display log and reindeer with 2 coats of Chocolate Fudge, followed with 2 coats of Chocolate and Medium Mocha. Highlight log and reindeer body with Light Umber. Apply 2 heavier coats to antlers and continue antlers with Buttermilk added to your brush. Drybrush signs with Buttermilk.

PAINT: Bark on log and hooves with Flat Black, drybrush bark and hooves with Chocolate Fudge, Chocolate and Medium Mocha. Paint trim on signs with Christmas Red. Paint eyes and noses with Flat Black. Apply non fired snow as desired.
