2622 "Welcome" Kitty 18"T x 11"W \$118.00

MATERIALS NEEDED

BISQUE UNDERGLAZE: Bright Delft, Light Delft, Light Purple and Bright Plum

GLAZE: Clear Glaze

OPAQUE STAINS: Chocolate Fudge, Saddle Brown, Medium Brown, Butterscotch, Curry, Dark Yellow, Oriental Flesh, Ivory, White, Peach, Bright Blue, Northern Blue, Cordovan, Garnet, Prairie Olive, Olive Moss, Avocado, Charcoal, Ash, Grey and Black.

PREPARATION: After cleaning greenware, replace texture to textured seamlines using the TL-9 texture tool. If making name tags for collars, place holes in collars to attach tag. (Tags are hearts cut out of a flat tile) Fire to cone 04.

BISQUE UNDERGLAZE: Apply 3 coats of Light Delft to inside and rim of cat bowl bird feeder. Paint cat's name to bowl and tags using Bright Delft. Pink tag apply two coats of Light Purple, name with Bright Plum. When dry apply two coats of glaze to cat bowl and tags. Fire to cone 06.

NOTE: PAINT DISH SOAP ONTO CAT BOWL AND ALLOW TO DRY, STAIN WILL REMOVE EASIER FROM GLAZE WHEN YOUR PROJECT IS FINISHED.

BASECOAT: Entire pieces with Chocolate Fudge.

DRYBRUSH: Cats with 1 solid coat of Saddle Brown, get into the texture except in the deep crevices. Follow with 2 to 3 drybrush coats of Medium Brown and then 2 coats of Butterscotch. Highlight with Curry and then with a small amount of Dark Yellow. Drybrush white areas including stripes, with Oriental Flesh followed with ivory and then White. Drybrush insides of ears, cheeks, noses, and pads of feet, lightly, with Peach.

REBASECOAT: Welcome sign, fishing pole handle and collars with Chocolate Fudge.

DRYBRUSH: Drybrush fishing pole and blue collars with Northern Blue followed with Bright Blue, highlight with White added to your brush. Drybrush pink collar with Cordovan followed with Garnet. Apply 2 coats

of Charcoal to Welcome Sign followed with Ash and then Grey, highlight with White added to your brush. Rebasecoat welcome letters with Chocolate Fudge. Drybrush letters with Persimmon, highlight with Dark Yellow added to your brush. Drybrush welcome base with Prairie Olive, followed with Olive Moss and then Avocado.

PAINT: Eyes using Bright Blue for the irises. Attach collar tags to collars with wire.

FISH NOTES: ALL FISH CAN BE USED AS WINDCHIMES USING THE SMALL WINDCHIME KITS. ALL FISH AND SEAHORSES CAN BE DRYFOOTED, YOU MAY NEED TO SPREAD THE FINS SLIGHTLY ON THE LARGE SUN AND ANGEL FISH WHILE THE CAST IS STILL DAMP TO MAKE THESE ITEMS MORE STABLE. SIDE FINS CAN BE CUT OUT FOR ADDED DIMENSION. PLACE MANY HOLES IN FISH IF USING FOR A MOBILE. WIRE USED IN THESE PIECES IS 18 GAUGE, THEY WILL NEED AT LEAST THIS STRENGTH AND MOST BEADS WILL FIT ON THIS SIZE WIRE. DO NOT SKIMP ON WIRE, YOU CAN CUT EXCESS OFF WITH SMALL WIRE NIPPERS. PLACE BEADS ON WIRE BEFORE IT IS BENT OR SHAPED, SOME BEADS WILL NOT PASS OVER KINKED WIRE. WIRE IS SHAPED EASILY WITH SMALL ROUND NOSED PLIERS. AFTER STRINGING PUFFER HUMMINGBIRD FEEDER, SEAL STRINGING HOLE WITH SILICON SEALANT TO SEAL, ALLOW TO SET 24 HOURS BEFORE USING AS A FEEDER.

2612 Lg. Butterfly Fish 11"L x 9"T \$45.00

MATERIALS NEEDED

OPAQUE STAINS: Curry, Dark Yellow, Concord, Persimmon, Ivory, White, Medium Green, Fire Thorn, Ultramarine, and Black.

TRANSLUCENT STAINS: Pecan Sparkle and Tan Sparkle.

BASECOAT: Apply stain to cone 04 or 05 bisque. Curry to Butterfly Fish, Persimmon to stripes. Fire Thorn to orange areas of the Clown Fish and Ivory to white areas of the Clown Fish. Apply Concord to body of Tang Fish and Persimmon to lips, fin and tail. Paint one small fish body with Medium Green, fin and tail with Ultramarine and one Curry, fin and tail with Medium Green.

ANTIQUÉ: All pieces with 1:1 mix of Pecan and Tan Sparkle. Wipe off excess with a soft cloth.

DRYBRUSH: **Butterfly fish** with 2 coats of Curry followed with 2 coats of Dark Yellow. Continue with Ivory added to your brush 2 to 3 coats. Highlight fish's belly with White added to your brush. Drybrush stripes with Persimmon, continue into the fins of the fish as shown, add Dark Yellow and then Ivory to your brush to lighten. **Clown Fish** with 2 coats of Fire Thorn followed with 2 to 3 coats of Persimmon, highlight with Dark Yellow added to your brush. Drybrush stripe with Ivory then White. **Drybrush Tang's** body with Concord followed with White added to your brush to lighten. Drybrush tail and fin and lips with Persimmon followed with Dark Yellow added to your brush to highlight. **Drybrush the green areas of the two small fish** with the original basecoat color followed by adding Dark Yellow to Lighten, other colors of the fishes drybrush the original drybrush color followed with White to highlight.

PAINT: Butterfly and Tang's eyes with Medium Green, Clown's eye with Curry and small fishes eyes with Persimmon. Drybrush eyes with the original color with Dark Yellow added. Paint a 1:1 mix of Medium Green and Dark Yellow to green areas of Butterfly fish and small dots on Tang. Black trim on Clown Fish, blue spots on Tang with Ultramarine. Dot small fish as desired. Paint black to pupils.

MATERIALS NEEDED

BISQUE UNDERGLAZE: Neon Coral, Neon Orange, Neon Yellow, Neon Green, Neon Chartreuse, Neon Blue, Bright Caribbean, Bright Purple, Bright Grape, Bright Delft, Dark Delft, Bright Heather, and Black.

FRENCH DIMENSIONS: Black Licorice, French Straw, French Scarlet, Neon Coral, Neon Chartreuse and French Papaya.

GLAZE: Clear Dipping Glaze.

MISC.: 18 gauge copper wire, small, medium and large plastic and glass beads.

PREPARATION: After removing casts from molds, place all holes desired using the small end of the # 2 Clay Lift tool, smaller holes with the large end of the #1 Clay Lift tool. Make sure you have hang holes, holes for wind chimes and holes to hang small fish and star fish from. Clean and fire to cone 04 or hotter.

PAINT: Small Seahorses were painted with one heavy coat of color as shown and dotted with Neon Chartreuse or Neon Coral. All other pieces were painted with 2 heavy coats. Paint inside of fins with contrasting colors or complimentary colors. Use French Dimensions as desired. Some fish have some blended colors, colors used on fish as follows:

2613 SUNFISH: Neon Green, Neon Yellow, Neon Orange, **(Dark Delft, Bright Delft, Bright Heather, Bright Grape, Bright Purple, then Bright Grape)** Colors in parentheses are the order the color is blended from the top of the fish to the bottom. Neon Yellow and Orange are blended as shown.

2614 ANGELFISH: Neon Chartreuse, Neon Coral, Neon Orange, Bright Purple and Bright Caribbean. Neon Red is blended with Neon Orange in body of the fish.

2616 TANG AND DAMSELFISH (DAMSELFISH ONLY): **(Dark Delft, Bright Heather, Neon Blue, Bright Caribbean)**, Neon Yellow, Neon Green, and Bright Jade. Color in parentheses is the order the color is blended from the top of the fish to the bottom. The green is a 1:1 mix of Neon Green and Bright Jade. Neon Yellow to lips and eyes.

2617 STARFISH: Bright Heather, Neon Green, **(Neon Yellow, Neon Orange, Neon Coral)**, Bright Caribbean. Color in parentheses is the order the color is blended from the tips of the star to the center.

2618 LG. SEAHORSE: Neon Orange, Neon Coral, Bright Purple, Neon Blue, Bright Caribbean, Neon Green, Neon Chartreuse, Neon Yellow, and Black. Black French Dimension.

2619 FIVE SMALL STARFISH AND 2620 FOUR FISH & ONE SEAHORSE: Using the colors already listed and French Dimensions decorate fish and starfish.

2621 PUFFER FISH HUMMINGBIRD FEEDER: Neon Coral, Neon Yellow, Neon Orange, Neon Green and Bright Purple.

WHEN ITEMS ARE DRY, DIP IN DIPPING GLAZE, HANG TO DRY AND REMOVE DRIPS WITH A BRUSH. WHEN DRY, DRY FOOT FISH BY SANDING ON A DRYWALL SANDING GRID, AND SPONGING OFF EXCESS GLAZE AT BOTTOM. FIRE TO CONE 06. ASSEMBLE AS DESIRED.
