PREPARATION: While casts are damp, place and cut out stars and holes if desired. Place any holes for electrical. When dry clean greenware and fire to cone 04.

BASECOAT: Color to areas as follows: **Orange Rust**- pumpkins, **Lime Burst** to green hats, **Dark purple mix** to Purple hats. **Purple mix** to ghosts with words, **Green mix** to plain smiley ghosts.

ANTIQUE: with Golden Buckskin, wipe off excess with a soft cloth.

DRYBRUSH: Areas with color as follows: **Purple ghosts**- 1 coat of the **purple mix** followed with White. Drybrush the color up to white slowly, if needed add a little of the purple mix to your brush if the color is getting to white to fast. **Green ghosts**-1 coat of the **green mix** followed with White. Drybrush the same as the purple ghost instructions. Blush cheeks with blush color of your choice. **Drybrush pumpkins** with 1 coat of Orange Rust, followed with 3 coats of Orange, and 3 to 4 coats of Brightest Yellow. Paint leaves with Lime Burst. Drybrush green hats, hands and leaves with I coat of Lime Burst followed with 3 to 4 coats of Brightest Yellow. Highlight hats and leaves lightly with White. Drybrush purple hats with 1 coat of dark purple mix, followed with 2 to 3 coats of the light purple mix, highlight with White. Paint stems with Chocolate Fudge and drybrush with Chocolate, Med. Mocha and Golden Ochre.

SHADE: If desired, shade green ghosts with Lime Burst and Purple ghosts with Dark Purple mix.

RE-ANTIQUE: If necessary re-antique the words with Golden Buckskin. Wipe off excess. With a clean cloth and paint thinner, finish wiping off the excess antique.

PAINT: With Black paint trees, tombstones and grass areas, with Brightest Yellow, paint the stars

and moon.

FINISH: Using gloss sealer and glitter, glitter stars and black areas. Using Matte Spray, spray the ghosts, the sealer helps to keep the glitter on.

PREPARATION: While cast is damp cut out as shown or desired and place all holes as desired for electrical and lighting. Allow to dry, clean and fire to cone 04.

BASECOAT: Orange Rust- Pumpkins and Lime Burst-leaves.

Antique: Using Golden Buckskin Twinkle

DRYBRUSH: Orange areas- 1 coat of Orange Rust, 2 to 3 coats of Orange and 4 to 5 coats of Brightest Yellow. Highlight with 2 to 3 coats of Brightest Yellow to center areas of the pumpkins. Blush cheeks lightly with Christmas Red added to your brush. **Paint the hands and green spiders with Lime Burst. Purple areas with Dark Purple mix.** Drybrush green areas with Lime Burst and Brightest Yellow. Highlight leaves lightly with White. Drybrush Purple areas with the dark purple and light purple. Highlight with White. Paint the stems with Chocolate Fudge, drybrush with Chocolate, Med. Mocha and Golden Ochre. Drybrush eyes with White. With the end of a brush dot the eyes with Black, add highlight with a dot of White.

FINISH: Using glitter and gloss sealer decorate spiders and ghoulies. Spray the pumpkins with matte sealer, this helps to keep the glitter on.

ANTIQUE: The pumpkins with a 1:1 mix of Camel Back and Water. Wipe off excess with a damp sponge.

FOR CUT OUT PUMPKINS: Apply a watery coat of Poo Bear to the inside of the pumpkins. **APPLY STROKE AND COATS:** Using a plate as a palette apply a puddle of each color as follows in a circle around the edge of the plate: Curry Around, Dee John, Tiger Trail, Jack O'Lantern, Poo Bear and Orange-a-Peel. Using a soft fan brush load with water and using Orange a Peel as the major color, draw color from each of the other puddles. You will not really be mixing the color as much as grabbing a bit of each on your brush. Integrate water into your loaded brush so the color in your brush flows freely over the bisque. Begin at the top of the

pumpkin and draw the brush down to the bottom. Continue this until the entire pumpkin is covered, use water to help blend if needed. Allow the first coat to dry before you apply the second coat. Using the same method apply Green Thumb, Army Surplus and Sour Apple, to the leaves. Paint the stems with 2 creamy coats using Tiger Tail. Paint leaf design with 2 good coats of Down to Earth. When dry, use clear dipping. **Fire to cone 06.**

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
