TRANSLUCENT STAINS: TL-309 Golden Buckskin Twinkle and TL-310 Ginny Tan Twinkle MAYCO BRUSHES: AB-834 <sup>3</sup>/<sub>4</sub>"Basecoat, RB-138 3/8"Angled Shader, Various size RB and size 4, 6 & 8 round CB brushes, UB and round AB

drvbrushes.

**PREPARATION:** After removing casts from molds, vent where necessary and slip attach father bunny. If you are lighting up, place proper holes in base and place holes in flowers as shown large enough for a small pin globe light. Allow to dry, clean and fire to cone 04.

**BASECOAT:** Color to areas as follows: **Medium Mocha** – bunnies bodies, **Buttermilk** – fence and mama bunny's collar, **Dark Blue** – dad's overalls and blue flowers (delphiniums), **Royal Fuchsia** – to kids overalls and all pink flowers, **Red** – all red flowers, **Honey Toast** – mom's dress and yellow flowers, **Deep Purple** – to purple flowers. **Accent Green** – Dark leaves and rose stems, **Forest Green** – medium leaves and base and **Country Sage** for light leaves. **Slate Gray** – watering can.

**ANTIQUE:** With a 1:1 mix of Ginny Tan Twinkle and Golden Buckskin Twinkle, wipe off excess with a soft cloth.

DRYBRUSH: Areas with colors as follows: Bunnies bodies - 1 to 2 coats of Medium Mocha followed with 1 to 2 Light Umber, highlight lightly with Ginger, blush cheeks, noses and insides of ears with Coral Rose. White fence and collar – 2 coats of Buttermilk followed with 3 to 4 coats of White. Yellow dress and flowers – 1 to 2 coats of Honey Toast followed with 1 to 2 coats of Brightest Yellow, highlight with White added to your brush. Blue overalls – 2 coats of Dark Blue followed with 2 to 3 coats of Bluberri, highlight with White added to your brush. Pink overalls and flowers – 1 to 2 coats of Royal Fuchsia followed with 2 to 3 coats White added to your brush. **Red Flowers** – 2 coats of Red followed with Orange to highlight. **Blue flowers** – 2 to 3 coats of Dark Blue followed with 2 coats of Deep Purple, highlight with Bluberri added to your brush. **Purple flowers** – 1 to 2 coats of Deep Purple followed by 1 to 2 coats, highlight lightly with White added to your brush. **Dark green leaves and stems** – Accent Green followed with Forest Green, Highlight with Country Sage. **Medium Green leaves and base** – Country Sage followed with Limeburst, highlight lightly with Brightest Yellow and then White added to your brush. **Light green leaves** – Limeburst followed with Brightest Yellow and then White added to your brush. Drybrush center of flowers with Brightest Yellow, highlight with White. Drybrush watering can with Slate Gray, highlight with Medium Gray. Using Shimmering Silver, lightly sponge on watering can leaving gray showing for a galvanized effect. Drybrush buttons on overalls with Emperors Gold.

**PAINT:** Paint eyes using True Blue for the irises. Paint flowers and leaves on dress. Hook up with electrical.

MAYCO BRUSHES: AB-834 <sup>3</sup>/<sub>4</sub>"Basecoat, RB-138 3/8"Angled Shader, Various size RB and size 4, 6 & 8 round CB brushes, UB and round AB drybrushes.

**PREPARATION:** Clean and fire to cone 04.

**BASECOAT:** Color to areas as follows: **Light Taupe** – flesh areas, **Medium Gray**– white areas, **Medium Mocha** - Boletus mushroom stem **Mink** to Parasol mushroom, **Chocolate Fudge** – brown areas & Boletus mushroom

cap, Accent Green – green areas, Light Umber – yellow cap, Orange Rust – orange areas, Deep Purple – purple areas, Antique Red – red areas and Dark Blue – blue areas.

**ANTIQUE:** With a 1:1 mix of Ginny Tan Twinkle and Golden Buckskin Twinkle, wipe off excess with a soft cloth.

**DRYBRUSH:** Areas with color as follows: **Flesh** – 1 to 3 coats of Light Taupe. Blush cheeks, noses and tops of ears and knuckles with Coral Rose added to your brush. **Mushrooms and funai on Welcome Sign –** Buttermilk, highlight with White. Beards, eyebrows and mustashe-1 coat of Medium Gray, heavy in center areas of beards, eyebrows and mustache, continue with White 3 to 4 coats. **Parasol Mushroom** – 2 coats of Mink followed with Buttermilk, highlight with White. **Yellow areas** – 2 coats of Light Umber followed with 2 coats of Honey Toast, highlight with Brightest Yellow and White added to your brush. Orange areas – 2 coats of Orange Rust followed with 2 to 3 coats of Orange, highlight with Brightest Yellow and then White added to your brush. Green areas - 1 to 2 coats of Accent Green followed with 1 to 2 coats of Forest Green and 1 to 2 coats of Country Sage followed with 2 to 3 coats of Limeburst. Highlight with Brightest Yellow and then White added to your brush. **Red areas** – 2 coats of Antique Red followed with 2 to 3 coats of Red, highlight with Orange and then a small amount of Brightest Yellow added to your brush. Purple **areas** – 2 coats of Deep Purple with White added to your brush to highlight. **Blue areas** – 1 coat of Dark Blue followed with 2 to 3 coats of Dark Blue and Bluberri mixed, highlight with White added to your brush. **Boletus Mushroom Stem** – 1 to 2 coats of Medium Mocha followed with Golden Ocher and Buttermilk. Boletus Mushroom Cap & Brown areas – 1 coat of Chocolate Fudge followed with 1 to 2 coats of Chocolate and Medium Mocha, highlight with Golden Ochre. Apply a couple extra coats of Golden Ochre to the Morel mushrooms. Drybrush a small amount of Orange Rust and Orange to the fungi on the large gnome Welcome sign. Drybrush 2 coats of Artichoke to tree bark.

**PAINT:** Eyes using Rick Blue for the irises, paint button and belt buckle with Venetian or Emperors Gold.

**GREEN WASH:** If desired apply a green wash to Lg. Welcome sign. Mix 1:1 Limeburst and Brightest Yellow plus 3 parts water. Apply to area over a sink with the water running. Apply paint mixture using a fan brush, using your fan brush retrieve water from the tap and apply on top of the green mixture adding more water and more paint until the item is covered, allowing it to drip freely, allow to dry undisturbed.

**ANTIQUE:** With a 1:1 mix of Ginny Tan Twinkle and Golden Buckskin Twinkle, wipe off excess with a soft cloth.

**DRYBRUSH:** Brown signs and posts as follows: 1 to 2 coats of Chocolate Fudge followed with 2 to 3 coats of Chocolate, Medium Mocha, Golden Ochre, highlight with Buttermilk added to your brush. Gray signs and Posts: 2 coats of Slate Gray followed with Medium Gray, highlight with White added to your brush.

**SHADE:** If desired shade posts using Black.

**GREEN WASH:** If desired apply a green wash as described in the previous instructions.

GLAZE: C-101 Blue White Clear Dipping BRUSHES: Mayco's #2 Soft Fan, 10/0 CB-110 Mini Liner MISC.: Mayco Medium Writer Tip and Bottle AC-222 and a straight pn.

**APPLY STROKE AND COAT:** Using the #2 soft fan, apply three even coats to 03 bisque base areas as follows: White area with 1:2 Speckled Vanilla Dip and White. Orange area – Orange a Peel. Green areas – Sour Apple. Light blue areas – My Blue Heaven, Calico Rooster's neck blend My Blue Heaven to Blue Isle. Yellow areas and tail - Poo Bear blended to Butter Me Up. Green and blue tail – Sour Apple blended to My Blue Heaven. Blue, green and yellow tail – Blue Isle blended to Sour Apple blended to Butter Me Up. Apply three coats of detail color as shown using all the base colors plus Limelight and Sunkissed. Line with Tuxedo. Using 1:1 mix of Cotton Tail an regular slip, place in the writer bottle and using the medium tip apply white dots as desired. Seal writer tip with a straight pin

for later use. Allow to dry and dip in C-101 Blue White Clear Dipping. Allow to dry and fire to cone 06.
