### **SCARECROW TRIO AND LARRY, MOE AND CURLEY SCARECROW MOLD NUMBERS**

**2936 SCARECROW/PUMPKIN TRIO 16" T X 12" W \$108.00**

**2937 LARRY SCARECROW 8" T X 4.25" T \$38.00**

**2938 MOE SCARECROW 7.25" T X 4.75" W \$38.00**

**2939 CURLEY SCARECROW 9" T \$38.00**

**PREPARATION: After removing Scarecrow Trio cast from mold, cut out pumpkins eyes and other area desired for lighting. If using a pinch socket place hole in back of piece. Allow to dry, clean greenware and fire to cone 04.**

**BASECOAT:** Color to area as follows: **Flesh mix:1:1:1/2 Medium Taupe, Peach and Coral Rose** – to face areas. **Chocolate** – shirts. **Brick Red** – pumpkins and overall pockets. **Golden Ochre** – straw. **Accent Green** – green areas. **Dark – Blue** - blue areas. **Country Apple** – red areas.

**ANTIQUÉ:** Basecoated areas with Golden Buckskin Twinkle, wipe off excess with a soft cloth.

**DRYBRUSH:** Areas with color as follows: **Face** – Flesh mix, highlight with Light Tan added to your brush. Drybrush nose and cheek circles with Coral Rose added to your brush. **Straw** – Golden Ocher followed with Honey Toast, Brightest Yellow and Light Yellow Orange, highlight with Buttermilk. **Shirts** – Chocolate to Medium Mocha followed with Light Umber add Buttermilk to your brush to highlight. **Pumpkins** – Brick Red followed with Orange, add Brightest Yellow to highlight. **Red areas** – Country Apple followed with Orange added to your brush. **Blue areas** – Dark Blue followed with Rich Blue, add Buttermilk to your brush to highlight.

**Green clothing** – Accent Green followed with Forest Green, Country Sage, Limeburst, add Brightest Yellow to your brush to highlight. **Green Leaves** – Accent Green followed with Artichoke and then Limeburst.

**PAINT:** Eyes, shoes and vines with Flat Black. Paint ropes on wrists with Chocolate Fudge. Paint stitches as desired.

**DRYBRUSH:** Black areas (except eyes) with Navy followed with Dark Blue and Deep Purple add Buttermilk to brush to highlight.

**FINISH:** If desired glue buttons to overalls as shown.

## **BUNDLE UP TURKEY**

### **MOLD NUMBERS**

**2934 BUNDLE UP TURKEY 13.5”T X 12”W \$98.00**

**2935 BUNDLE UP TURKEY HEAD \$15.00**

**PREPARATION:** After removing casts from mold, slip attach head to turkey body. Cut out as desired and place hole in back for pinch socket. If desired clean seams and cut outs while damp. Use dampened brushes to clean up word cut outs. Using a damp sponge, lightly dab to retexture surface.

Allow to dry, clean and fire to cone 04.

**BASECOAT:** Turkey beak and feet with Brick Red, waddle with Cranberrie, basecoat all other areas with Medium Mocha.

**ANTIQUÉ:** Golden Buckskin Twinkle, wipe off excess with a soft cloth.

**DRYBRUSH:** Medium Mocha to Medium Mocha areas, continue with Light Umber, highlight with Buttermilk added to your brush. Drybrush Feathers at the base with Brick Red, moving up the feather continue with Orange, Golden Ochre and Honey Toast, highlight with Buttermilk added to your brush. Drybrush beak and feet with Brick Red followed with Orange Rust and Orange. Highlight with Buttermilk added to your brush. Drybrush waddle with Cranberrie.

**PAINT:** Clear sealer to beak, waddle and feet. Paint eyes using Rich Blue for the irises. Shade feathers and face area as shown with Chocolate Fudge and then Flat Black if desired.

**FINISH:** Tie on napkin as shown or tie a fleece scarf around the turkey's neck. **Size of the fleece scarf is 24”L x 7.5”W, cut fringe on each end 2 ¼” long.**

## **BUNDLE UP SNOWMEN AND SNOWMAN STACK**

### **MOLD NUMBERS**

**2930 LG. BUNDLE UP SNOWMAN 14.75”T X 14”W \$108.00**

**2931 MED. BUNDLE UP SNOWMAN 11”T X 11”W \$65.00**

**2932 GANGBUSTER BUNDLE UP SNOWMAN (3) 5”T X 4.5”W \$40.00**

**2933 SNOWMAN HEAD STACK 19”T X 5.5”W \$108.00**

**2560 EXTRA SMALL BASE 5.25”L \$12.00**

**PREPARATION:** After removing casts from molds, cut out desired holes, stars, words and names. If desired clean seams and cut outs while damp. Use dampened brushes to clean up word cut outs. Using a damp sponge, lightly dab to retexture surface. Allow to dry and fire to cone 04.

**BASECOAT:** Blue Mix 1:1 Sky Blue and Light Blue – to snowmen and extra small base. Red – to red hats and Buttermilk to white trim. Dark Gray Blue to blue hats and Dark Blue to darker blue trim.

**ANTIQUÉ:** With a 1:1 mix of Ginny Tan Twinkle and Golden Buckskin Twinkle, wipe off excess with a soft cloth.

**DRYBRUSH:** Blue Mix to snowmen and extra small base, apply heavy to get into texture, continue with Buttermilk and then white. Drybrush Buttermilk hat trim with Buttermilk followed with White. Drybrush red hats with Red, highlight with Orange added to your brush. Drybrush Blue hats with Dark Gray Blue followed with Wedgwood Blue, Gray Blue and Buttermilk then White added to your brush. Drybrush hat trim with Dark Blue followed with Buttermilk added to your brush to lighten, lighten as desired.

**PAINT:** Noses with Orange. Drybrush noses with Orange mixed with Buttermilk. Highlight with more Buttermilk added to your brush. Shade mouths, around noses and below hats with Dark Blue. Paint eyes Flat Black.

**FINISH:** Using no sew fleece, cut out scarves for snowmen, cut fringe on both ends of scarf..

#### **NO SEW FLEECE SCARF**

**Snowman Stack** - 3"W x 16", 17", 19", 21" and 22.5"

**Large Bundle Up Snowman** - 6"W x 27"L

**Med. Bundle Up Snowman** - 4"W x 24"L

**Bundle Up Collectable** - 2" W x 8"L

**Turkey** – 7"W x 24"L

**NOTE:** On Snowman stack and collectable cut lengths longer so it is easier to tie, trim excess.
