MATERIALS NEEDED

OPAQUE STAINS: Deep Brown, Walnut, Burgundy, Night Blue, Electric Blue, Autumn Rust, Medium Brown, Country Gold, Christmas Red, Confederate Gray, Light Gray, Black Forest Green, Sherwood Green, Victorian Green, Vanilla, Dark Flesh, Peach Blush, Marigold Yellow, Bright Orange, Dark Blonde, Black and White.

BASECOAT: All pieces with Deep Brown.

DRYBRUSH: All black and white flesh, all bases and all white and yellow areas (including white girl's pom poms) with 2 to 3 coats of Walnut. Wet brush the color to the white flesh and any blonde hair and pom poms. Continue all these same areas except the black flesh and bases with 2 to 3 coats of Medium Brown, again wet brush the color onto the white flesh and any blonde hair and pom poms. Drybrush white flesh with 3 to 4 coats of Dark Flesh, blush cheeks and lips on white children with Peach Blush. Using a fresh brush, drybrush white clothing with 3 to 4 coats of Vanilla followed with 2 coats of White. Drybrush yellow clothing and blonde hair with 1 to 2 coats of Country Gold. Follow by drybrushing clothing only with 2 coats of Marigold with a touch of Bright Orange added. Highlight clothing and blonde hair with Dark Blonde added to your brush, further highlight with Vanilla added to your brush.

REBASECOAT: Black girl's pom poms with Confederate Gray. NOTE: When necessary, rebasecoat using Deep Brown, the areas that have been over drybrushed with the previous colors to prepare the area for the next color to be drybrushed. Example: Rebasecoat white boy's pants and green areas of the hat with Deep Brown so you can drybrush the green properly. Keep this process in mind with each new color of clothing or area.

DRYBRUSH: Colors to areas as follows: NAVY BLUE – 1 to 2 coats of Night Blue. GRAY – Confederate Gray 3 to 4 coats followed with 1 to 2 coats of Pale

Gray to highlight. RED – Burgundy 2 to 3 coats followed with 2 to 3 coats of Christmas Red. BRIGHT GREEN – 1 to 2 coats of Dark Forest Green followed with 2 to 3 coats of Victorian Green. GREEN – 3 to 4 coats of Sherwood Green. BRIGHT BLUE – 1 to 2 coats of Night Blue followed with 1 to 2 coats of Electric Blue mixed with Night Blue. BLACK – 1 to 2 coats of Black. FOOTBALL: 1 to 2 coats of Walnut. BASKETBALL: 1 to 2 coats of Walnut followed with Autumn Rust. BATS: 2 to 3 coats of Walnut followed with Medium Brown followed with Country Gold, lightly highlighted with Vanilla. BALL GLOVES: Walnut, to Medium Brown, lightly highlight with Country Gold.

PAINT: White children's dark hair with Black.

DRYBRUSH: Black children's cheeks and lips with Burgundy. White children's Black hair with 1 to 2 coats of Deep Brown followed with 1 to 2 coats of Walnut. If desired, lighten with Medium Brown.

PAINT: All detail. Paint blue streamers on white girl's yellow pom poms and paint Burgundy streamers on black girl's gray pom poms. Paint all eyes and eyelashes using Electric Blue and Turquoise for blue eyes and Walnut and Medium Brown for brown eyes. Paint detail on balls, helmets and uniforms as desired.
